

Does God Change His Mind

About His Word - Review

Bro. Lee Vayle - March 22, 1986

...you who listen to a tape the odd time, you'll find that I usually begin by reading what I have to say as the format and it's usually very, very precise to express myself as I understand what the prophet taught as explicitly as possible which as much clarity in order to help you to coordinate your thinking, which comes by your mind, which is the physical and the brain and through the spirit which God allowed but is not of God; to get down in your soul which is of God to feed the Christ within you, to hopefully come back into a manifestation for we're living epistles read and known of all men. And one day having bypassed that spirit body, either we go to it, or it comes to us in the Resurrection and we all go to the Wedding Supper.

So, that's our hope. So shall we bow our heads in prayer.

Heavenly Father, we want to thank You the opportunity we have being with these dear Saints of God whom we've known for some time. Many years actually and have always found grace with them; we appreciate that very, very much, hoping Lord that some good has come to them by way of a ministry that you've given us to teach a little of Your Word hopefully Lord, that It's one hundred percent what the prophet taught. We wouldn't want it any other way, we know that they would not want it either.

So, we ask You to bless us as we try to continue to show these principles in the Word which the prophet brought to clarify our hearts and our minds to know the direction which we're going, and to proceed and follow You in that particular direction which was so thoroughly exposed and vindicated to us by the one to whom...he was sent to us, were sent.

So Father, we look for Your help this morning and believe because we ask for that help which is truly legitimate and according to the Word we have It in the Name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

1. Now, back home I preached twenty one messages from about page 18 to 39 on this Message of: 'Does God Change His Mind About His Word', does He ever do that? And of course I took about an hour and a half on each message, which would bring us to almost thirty two hours of solid preaching. And in those twenty one messages I examined and explained and amplified some of the salient points given to us by Bro. Branham in that particular sermon of: 'Does God Ever Change His Mind About His Word'?

And this morning we're just going to sort of (although I finished the series) we're going to look at some of those points and review some of those points, and actually perhaps further illuminate and coordinate the material so it might be helpful to you. Now that's usually what you're supposed to do in a Message. You're supposed to lay out the material, and you teach, it's and then you attempt to coordinate it to the people, so that they are able to receive it. See that's,

pretty well how the Word is given in the first place. God vindicates Himself to the prophets, so the prophet knows that It's God. He's completely sold on the fact that It is God.

2. Then next, God has to vindicate the prophet to the people, so that they know as Nicodemus said, "We know that Thou art a teacher sent from God, known from God, for no man doeth the works You do, lest He be sent from God." [Jn 3:2]

And again, Dr. Luke in being a Scribe mentions that Jesus both began to do and to teach. And so you will notice as God comes on the scene to vindicate Himself to the prophet as in Moses He has to explain what He is doing, and why He has done that thing to Moses to get Moses comfortable and then oriented into those things which are to come.

Then He takes Moses and He brings him to the people, and before Moses ever says anything he has a series of miracles of vindication to let the people know that this man is superior to any one of them, that he has something that nobody else has. And this man should he say something would be able to tell them that which is right. So, now Moses after having demonstrated that this Power and Authority was of God, he then has to explain to the people all of that.

3. So you see, there's a constant progression of unfolding. And that's of course what happened in the church when they turned from the full Word of God as given by the apostle Paul, they begin to lay off and to back away from some of the things in Scripture; until the hour of the Dark Ages, which was over a thousand years. There were many that protested the Catholic church, but none of them had that which would bring the people out, and start from back a the progression where they would go back to where they came from. See? Because remember, the Ephesian Church was a perfect Bride Church, and to Her was revealed the coming of the Spirit in the end-time which would bring them into a perfection to the Tree of Life, where they could go away in a Rapture, and be ascended and be where Christ is and reign and rule with Him.

4. Well, you can see that the Light began to return under Luther. Now that particular time there has been a progression. And Bro. Branham said, *"Under Luther, it should not of stopped, but it stopped, it started under Wesley, and yet Wesley was a further progression of Luther, and when Pentecost came, it was a further progression of Wesley, and this now also is a further progression."*

But, the major problem is in every single time God brings a Message, God then takes away the messenger, sin comes in, reaps its tremendous results, the people die, and God has to raise up somebody else.

So therefore, we are literally a perfected Lutheran people. And yet, if you go amongst the Lutheran I would like to caution you, please do not think they know one thing about Martin Luther. Because I have his books, and I've heard the Lutheran preachers, and it just ain't so.

Now there he said, "Thou has the name that thou livest." Well now of course that refers to Christianity too, but, people like Luther got a name of Luther and they don't live it, they're deader than a door-nail. The Methodists are the same way, the Pentecostals now. And I have a good reason to believe that many, many people who call themselves Branhamites are deader than door-nails. And I can prove they've gone back to Pentecost in order to get a shot in the arm.

Well, they sure aren't going to take my coat off and give me a shot in the arm, and get away from this Message, because I feel enough in my soul without jumping and shouting, and screaming. Though I'm not against it. If you feel like jumping, screaming and shouting, that's fine, fine, fine, just do it in the right places.

5. All right. We want to be helpful this morning concerning this Message of Bro. Branham brought us concerning, "Does God Ever Change His Mind About His Word".

Now to begin with, Bro. Branham made a categorical statement in this Message, *"That God can no more change His Word than change (Himself)."*

In other words, he said, *"God can no longer be God if He changes His Word."*

Now, you're talking of course of the intrinsic depth of that which was in God, when...if I had a board here and I would illustrate, I would take the palest color I could possibly put on the board that you might see, draw a circle, and then I would take a piece of black chalk and I would write put over the top of it a smear, and all the time you would know that under that black smear there was that little ring of Light that represents God. But there's no way possible that you could see It. But in the intrinsicity of Almighty God, which means, 'which He actually is innately'.

No matter what you may see from the outside, or think you see, or hear, or think you hear, there is something in there that only Himself knows. That's His essentiality, and His intrinsicity that's God as God is, and you and I don't know a thing about it; for the very reason that we weren't even there, in the particular sense of what we are here now. Because, when you by-pass that one form being Seed, you have no memory of those particular things.

6. So, there's no way that God could possibly change his Mind about His Word and still be God. Now listen, If He changed His Mind about His Word He could not possibly be God, which is an object of worship, which worship is a true faith principle. Now why is it a true faith principle? I just told you.

There's no way that you can really know God, unless He Himself revealed Himself. Then if He revealed Himself, there's no way He could change His revelation. Now no matter what you see out here, or what you think you see, or what you hear, or what you are told about anything, there is no way that you truly know the intrinsicity of the thing, unless the thing can communicate to you what His own intrinsicity, that means His nature, what He really is, is all about, unless He told you.

So this is why I read what I read, the faith principle, see, you have got to have faith, because there's no other way you're going to have anything to do with God. Because you cannot shake His hand, you cannot talk in His ear, He cannot talk in your ear, there is...only in a certain prescribed way. But the averaged... no man can get to God. No man can see God and live.

7. So listen, If He changed His Mind about His Word, He could not possibly be God, which is an object of worship. Now do you understand what I'm saying? There's no way you could worship Him, if He changed His Mind, (He's an object of worship,) which worship is a true faith principle. You've got to throw your hands up and depend on Him. See? He's going to show you. For if He did change His Mind, His integrity would be at stake, and we could no more worship Him in good conscience nor faith, than He in good conscience could expect us to worship Him, because since He has changed His Mind about His Word, we no longer have any principles of truth for prescribed worship left to us.

So, He's no longer God and you ain't got a God. Now you see what I'm talking about? You've got blank faces this morning some of you. Now, come on, listen carefully, God is an object of worship, and you've got no way to reach Him. Tell me this morning how you reach God?

You say, "Bro. Vayle, I heard from God."

Phffft! You heard from God. Fap! Give me one, give me some evidence you've heard from God. You're stuck.

"Oh, I worship God."

Haah, tell me about Him.

"Well, He's a three person in one, indefinable, very exclusable (?), all of one nature, and, and, and..."

Yeah, shut up! Eight million people, eight million different ideas. Eight million ideas.

Then where does worship lie? And it has to lie in your imagination. And you say, "Well, God whether You like it or not, I suit You."

Where hey... If I was God I'd slap you down until there was nothing left of you. Because according to my own definition and intrinsicallity an innate nature, *"You don't tell me nothing,"* is what Bro. Branham said. *"You ain't got a think coming."*

8. So, now get your premise, there's a God who cannot change His Mind about His Word or He's no longer God. Then you say, "Oh, Bro. Vayle there's one thing left. Can I get to that Word?" See? Ha! That's the exact reason William Branham came on the scene. Now if you and I get to that Word, and we know He's unchanging, we are the only people who have a true God. You say what you want, He's out there as a True God, but they've got a false God. And the Bible says, "It's the God of their imagination and the Word."

Imagination is not, "Oh, I imagine this thing, and I imagine that thing. I'm a little child in a little dream world."

NO! The word imagination means 'reasoning's'. I'm reasoning. Well, God is not a reasoner! You say, "Bro. Vayle, the Bible says, 'Come now let us reason together.'" [Isa 1:18] That's you reasoning.

"Why do I have to reason about it? If anything if I'm creator and controller? Who do I answer to? Myself? Well, that's no problem, because I'm a hundred percent consistent. I'm the Lord I change not, else ye sons of Jacob would be consumed."

So, God cannot change His Mind about His Word and be God, and expect anything of us whatsoever. Because there is no way He could expect of us. And being God He would not expect of us. Now what kind of a God is He? See, where you're coming from. You simply cannot have those thoughts.

9. Now, that which I have just said is absolutely correct. For Bro. Branham said in this same sermon on page 17, [65-0427 DOES GOD CHANGE HIS MIND]

[79] *...the beginning of righteousness is God's revealed Truth, and the entire Church of the living God is built upon that.*

Now that's what he said. Page 17. Preached the whole sermon of two and a half hours one time years ago, didn't even know he'd said it. I knew I was right is saying it. And the Bible was full of it, and from what Bro. Branham, I knew he had to say it someplace, but I never knew he said it. And suddenly one day it struck me, and I said, "Oh God, I preached that sermon in Toronto, I preached all up and down in America and maybe overseas for all I know. And I don't even know what the prophet said.

The wife and I were going down the road one day in the car, and suddenly I heard it. I said, "Stop it, turn it back, just go again." And I heard it again. And he said in one split second what I said in two and a half hours. I was so happy. I was so happy, "The beginning of righteousness of God."

10. The beginning of the righteousness of God, the rightness that He has in Himself and imparts to us and wants us to be a part of It, and we must have in order to have a unity with Him, is God's revealed Truth. And that's true. When I explained it it's easy isn't it? Take that to some theological seminary they'd laugh you out of the courts. And I'd be happy to be laughed out. It's much nicer than just be thrown out. I've had that happen too. Ha, ha, ha.

The beginning of righteousness is God's revealed Truth and the entire Church of the Living God is built upon that. And remember, the true Church is the Bride in union with Her Husband, and of the same Mind and Substance, because we are one with Him, as He is One with the Father. And that's why Jesus in one place could actually be called the Logos, or the Word, or the strict manifestation of the thoughts of Almighty God. Or as Bro. Branham said concerning Jesus, "*What is the difference between God and Jesus?*" He said, "*Only one difference, Jesus had a beginning.*" And Paul said the same thing, "He is the out-roying of the substance of Almighty God." So you see, we're on good Bible ground.

11. Now, after that some of Bro. Branham's favorite Scriptures and we come up with Jn 6:63,

(63) ...the word that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and...life.

Notice that, that goes right in what we're talking about. And again Jn 4:23, very favorite.

(23) But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshipper
(will) worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father
seeketh such (that) worship him.

And always Bro. Branham quoted Mt 15:9 along with these same Scripture.

(9) But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the
commandments of men.

And even if they should stumble upon the fact of the One True God, and know thereby, positively have an insight that He is there, and they must worship Him. If they substitute one Word, or take one commandment of man against the Word, which God has revealed, their worship is vain! Though it may cost them their lives as Paul said, "Though I give my body to be burned," (and everything he said,) "To feed the poor it profits me nothing." [1Cor 13:3]

So there you are. How could God change His Mind about His Word? Once He gave It and established It upon the floods, and we're the floods.

12. Now, going back to the statement Bro. Branham made on page 17, combining it with the ones we already said, and that is: "*The beginning of true righteousness, the beginning of God's righteousness the righteousness of God, is the God revealed Truth.*" And the entire Church is built upon It.

Now, and also with that "the Words that I speak, they are spirit and life." And also the fact, "They that worship Me, must worship in spirit and in truth." And also condemning those who by-pass It, because he said, "In vain do you worship me."

He said, "No dice, no dice."

I want to ask you a question, before we go any further. What word do we have that God did not give us? Whether Bible or non Bible. You say, "Bro. Vayle, I think maybe the devil gave us... You're entirely wrong. Because you see, the devil can only give you what God gave him. The devil does not have a word of his own. Nobody has anything, because God is sovereign, He gave It all.

13. And even Michener saw the truth when he wrote about South Africa. He said, "The minute that you begin to pervert the word of a nation, (he said,) you have lost everything." He's one of the smartest authors living, with an insight to tell you flat, the minute language is perverted, nothing is left.

How strange that this man knows that and the theologians don't. It is strange that people have not considered, "Can there not be a way somehow in the grace of God that we can know the Word?" Well, you can join me and be despised for my stand. I take my stand with Bro. Branham, but it's very true.

14. Now, having taken our thoughts back again, the Righteousness of God, His Word Spirit and Truth, the Word Spoken, Spirit and Life, you cannot worship apart from the real Truth, the real Word. If you do, it's all vain, it won't do you any good anyway.

We are going to go to 1 John the 3rd chapter, and we are going to see these things which I constantly preached, because there is such an necessity. For I know only too well the more I preach it, the better it gets to me in the clearer, and the more the Lord shows me and consequently, I trust shows you. [1John 3:]

- (12) Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother.
And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil,
and his brother's righteous.

All right, here's two men, notice: one's work is righteous, and one is not. Okay, let's go back and get a context. Verse 7, [1 John 3:]

- (7) Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness
is righteous, even as he is righteous.

Ah ha, now he that doeth righteousness is righteous. And he couldn't do righteousness unless he was righteous. And if he does righteousness and we know it is righteousness, we know that he is righteous. [the underlined said with a song tone] You don't believe that do you? Did you catch it? I sing songs on purpose. Yeah. I caught your attention by what I was doing, and I hope you got what I was saying.

- (7) ...he that doeth righteousness is righteous...

15. In other words, there is a certain performance here that in itself is righteous, and only the guy that does that performance can do it, because He in Himself is righteous. Huh? Right or wrong? Some of you still are non committal, you better grow up. I don't play tootsies you know in church. I read It to you. Huh? (Hee, hee, hee.) I love It myself, because I think this is fantastic. And you know, even as He is righteous, that tells you that man is part of God.

- (8) He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from
the beginning...

Now what's he saying here?

(7) Little children, let no man deceive you:...

It's very evident that something comes out...in the strength of righteousness, it's an act, it's a manifestation, it's something that is being done, and it could only come by the fellow that has it inside of him, and he lines right up with God. Hey, absolutely He's One with the Father.

No! Hey, you cannot separate Him from God.

(8) ...(But) he that committeth sin is of the devil;...

In other words, he that doeth unrighteousness, he has unrighteousness dwelling in him. Yeah! Even as God has allowed this manifestation in you, and through you, proving that you are a part of Him from the beginning, so these guys here are manifesting something proving that they have something in them which is from the devil in the beginning.

Who wants to believe that junk? They'd sooner believe we're all reprobates, we're all goats, we're all pigs, we're all dogs, and somehow by the grace of divine alchemation the gold is turned into a sheep. And the dog is turned into a sheep. And the hog is turned into a sheep. Hell, everything is turned into a sheep. HOGWASH! Original seed is what's it's all about and what it's all going back to.

16. Jesus said, "Other sheep I have, I'm going to bring them too." He didn't say one thing about a swine, the dog. He said, "Every plant my Heavenly Father has not planted I'll uproot and burn." And He said, "Even the chaff which is so close looking as though it were the real thing I'm going to burn."

Do you know this morning brother/sister that no Pentecostal will be in the Rapture? Because the chaff burns. "Oh, I understand Bro. Vayle, brother..." Oh, you're all so scared to believe God's Word, what is the matter with you? See, you sit here this morning and you want to change It?

You say, "Bro. Vayle, you're mad." No, I preach this way, because a lot of people outside get these tapes. I got a mean raspy spirit on me. And you know why? Because if I'm preaching wrong from this Bible what the prophet said, I haven't got a chance and I know it. I'm not kidding you. You kid if you want. "I believe this, I believe that." I don't care what you believe. It doesn't bother me one bit, do what you want to do. I read It to you.

17. There's two guys, they're both doing something, they both identify those two, they are both from the beginning. Huh? That's it's right. Except I'm mean as could be, I think Bro. Branham would appreciate my preaching. He told me somebody had to tell them. Don't worry I know what I'm doing. [1 John 3:]

(7) Little children, (don't) let (anybody) deceive you...

No, no. I've got a way of letting you know these things.

(8) He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth
from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was
manifested, that he might (bring to nothing) destroy the works
of the devil.

What's he telling you? That He can establish in you the proper manifestation, the right way; which if you have it in your heart from Him is a Seed to begin with, you will respond to It, thereby, showing you that you are that one.

18. In other words, there's a certain evidence that you are a child of God. Yeah!

(9) Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

What is he talking about? Righteousness and unrighteousness which comes through two kinds of people. Yeah! Manifesting what seed lies in there. And if there's an unrighteous, or an evil thing there then the person is intrinsically evil. The same as, brother/sister, let me tell you flat, if there's a fruit on a tree hanging out here that'll kill you when you eat it, there must have been something in the life of that tree that brought that poison there to kill you. Uh? Well, come on, in Genesis, the Book of Genesis tells you that, the tree is good to eat, because the seed is in it.

I'm not mad, I'm just a tough preacher. Notice how strong my voice is these days. [laughter] Oh yeah. You know I just kid you, I like to break the tension every now and then.

19. All right,

(9) Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him...

Didn't I tell you? Got ahead of myself, the Lord doesn't mind. You see, I know the Scriptures that's it.

He cannot sin! Because he's born of God. What is the word 'born' mean? It's not a creative act. It is an issuing act of what is already there. The baby issues from the mother's womb. Neither is birth a creative thing, it is simply the life coming through proper channels.

Now that which is born of God, issues forth from God cannot sin, because of that particular Seed. There then has to be a manifestation which God demands, which is congruent with what lies in the One that issues It forth. And so therefore, the child that God lines up with the father safe and secure with the father, and he knows these things. But you see, they've been lost to the church, because the church does not believe in grace, it believes in works. Yeah.

20. Now,

(10) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God,...

Now, leave that part out of love right out there in the beginning, because an unborn baby cannot love, and when the baby is born it doesn't understand a thing about love and the precepts, it is just there living. So when this was thrown in here, it's an interpolation. So everybody reads the interpolation, and as soon as they do their minds completely gone, the teachers giving a little dissertation here and how to make candy, and how you make fudge and suddenly a little pertinent thought comes in, and the teacher leaves the making of the fudge and goes over here to something else, and everybody forgets about the fudge, and takes all the time over here, and you never get the recipe.

So here's the recipe: cut out those verses temporarily and go on down to verse 12. Let me read It again.

(10) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil:...

In other words, he's telling there's two groups of people and there's a manifestation there, because of such and such a certain thing we've discussed, and It says,

- (10) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil:
whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God,...
- (11) For this is the message (you) heard from...(not that...)
- (12) (But) not as (in) Cain, who was of that wicked one, (just leave
out verse 11 too. [the last part of verse 11])

Now, he talking about righteousness and unrighteousness according to what was manifested, these two people doing it:

- (12) Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother.
And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil,
and his brother's righteous.

21. Now, what were the works that they did? Worshipping God in two different manners! The unrighteous act wasn't killing his brother, that took place after the unrighteous act. You follow me? "So Bro. Vayle, is it not unrighteous to kill somebody?" I never said it wasn't! I'm just telling you what caused him to kill his brother, they were both worshipping God. Yeah! And the true Seed had something from God within him that responded to a certain regimen, which had to do with the intrinsicallity of Almighty God, which was His Own thought or Word, which He could not change, because God's Word. He's Rehma Logos, Elohim, Omniscient, Omnipotent, and demanding.

Now, these two boys stood right there, twins, and one did a righteous thing, and one did an unrighteous thing. And by the way they worshipped you could tell who was of God, and who wasn't period! Now, that's a hundred percent true prototype, and everything is based upon it, because it comes out of Genesis and it ends in Revelation, and we are in the hour where you and I are a hundred percent differentiated from the rest by how we worship according to the Word.

"So, Bro. Vayle, I believe it's something else."

Well, you believe any stinking thing you want. I'm going to preach what I want, believe me I'm going to keep preaching till the cows come home, and then the sheep come home and I come with them.

22. All right, now listen, What I read here is based upon Genesis 4, and I told you about it. And It says here in the 3rd verse.

- (3) And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the
fruit of the ground and offering unto the LORD. (Worship God.)
- (4) And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock the fat
thereof. And the LORD had respect (to) Abel and his offering:
- (5) But unto Cain his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very
wroth, and his countenance fell.
- (6) And the LORD said (to) Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is
thy countenance fallen?

Listen, this is a conversation of God with an unrighteous person. Huh? Do you wonder why preachers and we argue with people to turn to God, and there's no way they will turn. It starts right here. God argued. After Abel argued, God argued. And Cain filled his mouth full of spit

and pttth, right in God's face. Ahh, ohh, [Bro. Vayle makes a sound like someone horrified]
"Hey, I,I,I, don't believe that could happen."

Hey, where you've been? Pinch yourselves, are you alive or dead this morning? Have you ever heard and believed anything in your whole cotton-picking lives? You don't believe the Bible.

"Oh, Bro. Vayle you see the thing is that...that sounds very strange and I don't know that that could happen." [Said in a disparaging tone.]

23. Well it did happen!!! It said right here. You know these walls could fall down and some of you still would go to sleep. I'm not fussing at you, I tell my same...our congregation back home the same thing. I know what goes on in people's minds. Should I tell you one thing, I've learned two things as a teacher, because I did take good teacher training class.

Number one: Had to go through requires, repetition, repetition, repetition, Paul said so.

Number two: You make them laugh.

Or three,: You hit them so hard they don't dare forget.

I try all three. [laughter]

Yeah, God taunted His man. "But unto Cain and his offering he had (no) respect." Here's this fellow worshipping God. It was vain. What made it vain? Jesus said, "Your doctrines, you're changing My Word, they're in vain, it's no use." He said, "I don't say that you're not worshipping Me, no, no. And I don't say you're not trying to be a better man. And I'm not saying you're trying to get your prayers answered, and create favors with Me, and live in more harmony."

"Well," he said, "I can't take it."

"Oh, what kind of a God is that."

Ah ha, you see you've got God in your own imagination. You don't have a sovereign God, you've got some little dotty grandfather, some old puss up there that you know, strokes, stroke, pat, pat, purr, purr you know. Forget it honey child, forget it.

24. Listen kid I know full well, I'm before the White Throne now, and I'm going to be judged even more so. And I want to stand before God believing my best and knowing of this, if I don't make Bride at least I gave the devil a rough time. And the rest are this crud that goes...supposed to be worshipping God.

"Bro. Vayle do you really worship God?"

By the grace of God I hope I do on one thing alone, 'revealed Truth'.

Now, I hope you got three hours to go, because I ain't got past hardly anything here.

[Genesis 4:]

(6) And the LORD said (to) Cain, Why (are you angry?) why is
(your) countenance fallen?

(7) If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted?

He doesn't say that according to the Greek Septuagint. "Thou hast offered right, but if thou hast not rightly divided, hast thou not sinned?" And the great cardinal thing, one of them is, "Do not mis-divide the Word of God."

He said, "What you did...I can see it all from your point of view. But you refuse to see My point of view, and all, it is My point of view alone prevails and get with It boy, because I'm God."

25. Now, I know everybody this morning wants to think God wants us to jump through a hoop, climb over a mountain with every soul and do everything, and love everything, sweet everything, this everything and you know, say, "Well, hallelujah, Jesus hallelujah, Jesus, well we've that so important hallelujah Jesus."

Hogwash! It isn't "Hallelujah Jesus," because Cain did hallelujah Jesus, and God rebuked him and kicked him out. Abel stood there like a sour-puss, he said, "I'm right and you're wrong." And he said, "I know I'm right, because the fire came down and took mine and left yours. In case I want to tell you something, I'm going right to God for this."

White Throne was right there. White Throne was already there. He went right before God and God said, "You're wrong Cain."

"What do you mean, I'm wrong?"

"But," He said, "You are." Oh Cain was mad.

Now, he's going to buy by a big four foot club, pull God down out of heaven, and as Rob Barnard(?) once said, "Beat hell out of God with a club, because you don't believe in sovereignty you're mad at him."

So what did he do? He killed God's child. What for? Didn't like the way he worshipped. Same Bible, same God, same everything, couldn't take that worship.

You see why people hate you and think you're nuts and everything else? Now you can't be a nut if you're not listening this morning and understand what I'm saying. You're just half a nut wishing you were a nut.

They killed Paul, because he was a heretic according to how he worshipped. They killed Jesus for the same reason, yet they all had the same Bible. But Israel forgot what a prophet really was, and the Gentiles don't even believe in Him.

26. All right. Let's go to 2 Timothy, that's a nice Book... 2:15.

(15) Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

How are you a workman, a worshipper? A workman and a worshipper. How are you going in the foreign field and serve God? How do you worship God outside a right division? See?

[2 Timothy] 3:16-17.

(16) All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

Instruction in righteousness. Notice, instruction in righteousness, how to be righteousness. Now, serpent seed can't take it, so they turn it down. Child of God says, "Hey, that's great, I like that."

(17) That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Notice, the good works follow that, because from that point on no matter even if it's a glass of cold water, you get a reward. Without it, "depart from me." We'll talk about that.

27. All right. And today we go to Revelation the last chapter [22:] and verse 10, which is after the opening of the Seals.

(10) ... he (said) unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

(11) He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: he (that's) filthy, let him be filthy still: he that is righteous, righteous still: he that is holy, holy still.

He's letting you know there's coming a dividing time when there will be a group that is absolutely holy and righteous, the Bride spotless and ready for presentation after the opening of the Seals.

(12) And (he said,) behold, I come quickly; (Now, this is the Second Coming actually,) my reward is with...gives...his work(s) (of man) shall be...(has many connotations...)

(14) Blessed are they that (wash their robes...have (the) right to the tree of life,...

The division's right there.

(15) ...without...(there are) whoremongers, murderers, (and so on, and so on.)

And then right down in verse 18,

(18) (But) I testify unto every man that (hears) the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, (which) God (has said,) God (will give) him the plagues...

(19) ...if (he) take away the (word) God (will) take away his part out of life, and the holy city...

What's doing it? His works? No! His Words! Bro. Branham says, "*Don't take one Word away, don't add, say what I say.*" You see, I've quoted from and I know what I'm talking about.

28. Now then, at this point I think we are very clear on the point, so we can move on to another point, and then come back to what I said. I'll give you some more notes on it.

Number two: Concerning this sermon. For this point we refer to the Scripture Bro. Branham used as a Scripture basis for his sermon.

What was the basis? It's a story of Israel having left Egypt under Moses, and there they are going through the land of Moab, and the Moabites know all about the fact of Israel is cleaning everything up in its path, so therefore, they fear for their destiny. And they know there's a man named Balaam who's a prophet, who's very, very successful, what he says comes to pass. And they know that some of the things he comes to pass have been blessings, and some have been cursings. You know, good times, and bad times. So therefore, they say, "This is the guy we want."

Now, if he is adept at both blessing and cursing, he can begin to move the hand of God in blessing and in cursing, "We want him to move the hand of God and cursing and get rid of these bums."

29. Now you see, those people were just like a certain fellow that came through here a few years ago, he said his name was Robert Thom.(?) And he said to a guy named Charlie...what's his name... anyway, this guy had a motel in Pennsylvania and he could never sell it. And this guy prophesied to Charlie that the motel would sell now at such a price. And Charlie got so carried away with...he's dead now this guy, but you talk about a man that was a hundred percent rascal, and don't worry, Bro. Branham told me all about him, I'm not telling you a lie.

He was so enamored, then I knew that this guy would take him over and fleece him, because I know his record. Money, women, what have you. I don't know which he had more, money or women, but he sure had a lot of both.

So I said, "Charlie, let's be honest, did this man's prophecy sell your motel, or did God just let him in on the secret that your motel is going to be sold?" He saw the light.

These Midianites did not see the light. A prophet does not prophesy and bring a thing to pass, a prophet is a 'seer', he sees what is going to come to pass. And yet a stranger gets somebody prophesying in church, and they take the church over.

30. Like this bird down there in Missouri, you know, this guy with the long eight inch pick, was to perfect the church. Bro. Hancock had him in his church, some friends of mine phoned us and said, "Lee this is terrible," he said, "This guy is really murder, he's prophesying things and the church is not in order."

They told me the story, so I phoned Bro. Hancock and I said, "Bro. Hancock I'd like to talk to you, as a friend, as a brother." I said, "Hey, you've got this fellow named O'Dell, O'Dell what's his African name anyway, Fredrick's; in there he's prophesying, but he doesn't come to church where his prophecy is under order."

"Well," he said, "You see Bro. Vayle he lives out in the country and all, and you know, it's difficult."

I said, "Now jjjjjust hold it, hold it, hold it." And I said to Bro. Hancock, "Does he get his prophecy at home and bring it to church?"

He said, "Yeah."

I said, "That's where you're wrong. If he can get it at home he better get it in church, in a little room where first of all you got to demand the door the man with the discerning of spirits, and let the brethren judge it."

He said, "You don't understand Bro. Vayle."

I said, "Bro. Hancock I do understand, you're the guy that doesn't. But it's okay, it's all over, you are going to reap the whirl wind."

He presented that guy around the country with his stupid long pick going to perfect the Bride. He wrote a letter, and he said, "This man O'Dell will perfect a Bride."

The brethren jumped on him and he denied he wrote the letter. So they showed the letter. Now the guy is not only a fool, he's an idiot, he's a liar.

31. So this guy goes to Europe, I even got a letter about it, and they warned me you know, that he got a vision. This one fellow saw me in a vision, a great voice thundered in heaven and struck me down over this guy. Phfffft! I'll hit him hard this morning and every morning, because the guy is a liar! Quoting from Bro. Branham the Bible, music is going to perfect the Bride. The Blood perfects the Bride!!! "She's dressed in a garment of the Word, without spot, without wrinkle." Don't you come around as some jerk in an audience as you can preach a bit, you can play a bit and you think you fool me with that Word kid, I'll fight you to the death.

"Hey Vayle, you're mean."

Thank God I am for some of you folk. Myself I don't care two-bits about that crap. I've got a cesspool in my house big enough to handle it.

What about it, brother/sister, it ain't ho-yeah. Yeah. "Balaam ...?... your mount Balaam, curse him. Why we've seen blessings come when you said it. And we saw cursing come when you said it. So ha, we know a little secret. You can twist God....put the old arm-lock on Him, make God curse them."

He said, "Boys you've missed the point. I only tell what I see. I don't have any gift to make anything come to pass."

But they still chose to disbelieve him. And they said, "Well listen bud, hey, you don't know the money that's involved in this thing. Boy, you've had it tough up here by yourself. A little trick, a little dribble, but you come on down and stand there and curse him and we see it works. It won't be a trickle and a dribble it'll be a torrents. You'll be next to the king, you'll be the bishop, you'll be the prime minister and anything you say go. Hey listen, between you and me kid, we can really revolve the empire."

And the wheels begin to turn, 'tune,tune,tune,tune. He said, "Well, give me some time."

"Well, okay."

32. They thought he was shrewd, like a used car-dealer you know. My definition of a real slimy scum is when I talk about a man that's a cross between a used car-dealer and a back-slidden Pentecostal preacher, [some chuckling] and he was one of them. They said, "We know how to get him, we'll be back tomorrow." They said, "We've raised our price, we can see your point Balaam."

Now, God told Balaam don't you go. When Balaam got so anxious to go, God said, "Okay, go ahead. Go ahead." The guy knew better. He even had a donkey speak in tongues. As one guy said back there was good, he said, "You could...the donkey spoke in tongues in those days, but now you can't get all the donkey's to stop speaking in tongues."

That was some bishop said that, and he said it right.

But anyway the donkey couldn't do it anything about it, God couldn't do a thing, but he went down anyway. Two times he prophesied, and he prophesied what God was going to do, because hey, it was out of Balaam's hand, he had a gift, and believe me I know enough about gifts to know how they operate. Because I know under certain conditions and I'm not lying to you, you come against the Word of God I could blow you plumb out of the waters so fast your head would swim, because a gift is a gift. You just stand back and watch it. You see, Balaam knew how to do it.

33. I said to Bro. Branham one day, "Bro. Branham I'm looking at these things about a prophet, these things in the Bible."

"Yeah, what is it, Lee?"

"Well," I said, "They had a little formula, a little trick, a little thing they knew just what to do, and when they did it they slid into it and dong, dong, dong, down came the prophecy like to Balaam and down came..."

"Well," he said, "Certainly Lee, he took up his parable." And you'll hear it right on a tape. "I take up mine too, but I will not tell you the words."

So if you know the first thing about ...?... you just... peculiar you can even just walk into it. If you don't know it I can't explain it to you. You just take my word for it. You just suddenly go blank.

As Bro. Branham said, *"My great gift is to get out of the way."* And that's what a gift is, you just go cold to everything. It begins to move. Balaam knew it, but he was absolutely convinced for money, he would make it work, or he would make a reasonable facsimile work, but couldn't make the reasonable facsimile work, because he didn't have the things we've got today like the microphones and the things you put in your ears and little stuff you pull off, he couldn't do that, didn't have that back there. So he couldn't do what he wanted to do.

34. So all right, the text...the Scripture that Bro. Branham used, Israel has come out of Egypt under the prophet Moses to whom God revealed and vindicated Himself, and then vindicated Moses to the people in order to lead them out, and give them His Word preparing them for the Promised Land. That's Deuteronomy.

On their way to Canaan they came into the land of the Moabites. Now these people were worshippers of God, for they descended from Lot, the nephew of Abraham, and Lot came out of the Ur of the Chaldeans as did Abraham, and substantially for the same purpose, but not in the depth as did Abraham, for God appeared to Abraham and His seed. And Bro. Branham said, *"You may not be a silver dollar like Abraham, you might be just a ten cent piece like Lot."* ...?... Now these guys came down from the Ur of the Chaldeans and they had a right revelation of God. All right, we know the story and I told you some of it. See?

35. Now, like Lot they wanted the best. Now watch, Abraham and Lot are together. God said, "Separate, separate, separate."

Abraham said, "Lot, tell you what, what you want you take, I'll go this way."

Notice the spirit now. Lot looks up, "Ah, well watered plains. Ah, city over yonder. Hey that's the best." All boiled down to money, prestige, hymn and glory, give me, give me, give me, give me.

Abraham said, "Be my guest. I'll go to the mountain, (that represents God,) I'll go to the hard place," that represents a virtuous life that God breaks into and brings forth and the power and glory of Himself. See, these people came from the wrong seed and the best they could do would be a class of foolish virgin. That at the end-time Bro. Branham classed the foolish virgin with the wicked and the unrighteous and with the dogs. Did you know that? Well, did you know that? Well did you know it? Uh? I sure know a lot of you never hear my tapes, you don't even hear Bro. Branham's. Yeah, blink your eyes.

When the Bride went out, the foolish virgin died. They were classed with the wicked, the unrighteous, the filthy and the unholy. He said so. You've got to know your tapes. If you don't know your tapes you cannot know this Bible. How are you going to worship God right when you've got in your heart some fallacy that this is that, and that this?

"Come out from among them and be ye separate," and you'll prove you're a son and a daughter. "Touch not the unclean thing." Yeah. Don't want to be too tough, but that's the truth.

Now, did God change His Mind about His Word? Oh, how could God change His Mind about His Word cursing Israel? (How much time we've got, all the time in the world?) Well, you guys asked for it. Never ask me to preach, because I make up what I'm sure is enough notes for an hour and a half and we're three hours sitting there. Okay.

36. I'm not going to read the whole chapter of the Book of Genesis the 15th chapter. Abraham absolutely is told by God when God said, "What am I going to do, I don't have any seed?"

- (3) And (God) [Abram] said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.
- (4) And behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.
- (5) And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look toward (the) heaven, tell the stars, (if you can, look on the seashore tell them, so on,) So shall thy seed be. (That's exactly what God said to him.)

Now then, in Exodus 3:1-12, we get the very same thing. Because in this same chapter here, It tells you in verse 13, he said to Abraham (this is Genesis 15:)

- (13) ...Know of a surety thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and (they'll be) afflict(ed) for four hundred years; (then I'm going to bring them out.)

Now, in the Book of Exodus, God repeats His promise. And in Heb 6:13, It tells you, listen now, It tells you then when God made promise to Abraham at this particular point, seeing He could swear by no greater, He swore by Himself. Then God and His Word is One and the same. And if God ever changed His Mind about His Word He's no longer God. Do you follow me?

37. Let's go to Hebrews 6: is too good stuff in there to just let that go by the board. Well didn't go by the board, we just didn't go far enough. Okay, now we read down to, "He swore by Himself. Now listen, verse 16,

- (16) For (verily men) swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.
- (17) Wherein God, willing more abundantly to (show his) heirs of (the) promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

Now just a minute, neither God changes, nor does God's Word change. It tells you right there. Why? Because if He did there wouldn't be one true worshipper, even though he was a Seed. You'd become a...what do you call these Baptist...you know, the Baptist they're hyper-Calvinest. They don't say that we're born again, they say, "We have a hope." You know, they're what they called...(can't remember the word now,) they're hyper-Calvinest is one way of

turning... they're antinomianists. Which means 'there's no means of salvation', you don't need it. You're seed and that takes care of it. Hard-shell! This is not hard-shell, although it is to the degree.

Now look it, if Bro. Branham said, he said, *"If God knew every flea and how many times he bat his eyeballs, how is He going to change His Word?"*

"Well, he miscounted."

They miscounted the Bride of Christ. Then he blew it. This is True Word. Well, this is nearly True Word, and this is not quite so, and by grace he threw this one in. Do you believe that? How can you? How can you?

38. Now notice carefully, Two prophets, two headships, two people. Boils down to a true vine, and a false vine based on the kind of seed which was in the life, or the life in the seed, and both claimed to be the receiver of grace. The True Seed, the True Life, and the True Worshipper. But one bunch will kill the other.

Now, we're in a good place at the end-time to be killers. What about the Bride in the end-time? "Just get me out of here Lord. All I stand for is Your Word, if this ain't It..." You see what I'm looking at, telling you, if this isn't It, where do you go? If It isn't Word, where do you go? Vindicated Word.

39. Now, only one prophet was truly commissioned of God, to lead the people of God though both had offices. Now we already read about Moses and to add weight let us read also about men like, well, Paul and Jeremiah, we don't have to. Paul said, "Who separated me from my mother's womb?"

God said to Jeremiah, "I separated you from your mother's womb, I put the Words in your mouth."

Paul said, "My Message is not of man myself, nor of men. I got It straight from God, the Pillar of Fire three years in Arabia." Then Paul turns around to a church that went to gifts, and bypassed the Word, and what did he say, "The women now were having a great time."

Now you women, if you're around me continuously, you'll swear Lee Vayle is a woman hater. I am not. God is my Judge. I stick up more for the women than I do for the men. But oh do I get mad when you stick with it and they are so cotton-picking stupid when it comes to the Word. They just won't listen.

But listen, he said, "Let the women keep silence in the Church for it's not permitted them to speak." Now, that's to the Bride as well as just the woman. They are commanded to be under obedience is also saith the law.

To be obedience to what? Well if they can't talk and their husbands can, they're obedient to Christ, and Christ is the Word. And He's told you what He wants from the woman. And Bro. Branham correctly said, he said, *"What the Bride does, She supplies to the Groom what the Groom supplies to Her that She works with."* So you give back to God His Word.

40. Now, and if they won't learn anything let the master husband's at home, that's head-ship, "For it's a shame for women to speak in the church." [1Cor 14:35]

Now watch, "Came the Word of God out from you, or came It unto you only?" [14:36]

"Now if any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge the things that I write are the commandments of the Lord." [14:37]

In other words, he said, "If you have the Holy Ghost, now you are a prophet, you will know right away that this is the truth, and you won't buck it. And that's so important to understand that. Okay, let's go a little further. I'll finish up before the night's over, don't worry.

40. Now, what we are seeing here, is Balaam refusing to come under a Higher Authority, that's what Bro. Branham said, and use the gift to come against Moses, even later as did Korah. Now what did this guy do? He had a genuine gift from God, there is no doubt about it. And he was with a people of God, they worshipped the same God. But they refused to come under vindicated authority. Now it wasn't that the gifts were not authoritative, but there was a Higher Authority. Uh?

You know why everything has gone to hell in this world? There is an authority in people's flesh called 'sex', but there's a Higher Authority It says, "Do it only in marriage." One wife, a woman not a man, or another woman or anything else. And they have gone exactly with the authority of sex. And it's authoritative, and when it's between a man and a woman that's properly married it is a righteous act. Oh yes. But now they got AIDS, and the church spiritually is full of AIDS, because they're going through the acts illegally.

Everything's typed brother/sister, don't you ever believe different. This man had a gift a genuine gift, and he came against Moses as did Korah later who said, "Hey, we all got something from God. Don't tell me prophet Moses that you're the only guy that's got something from God."

And he said, "I never said that!"

"Would to God they all prophesy."

"Get off my back," William Branham said that, "Get off my back." Oh yeah. It was on a tape Chicago, preached to the people up there about one God. "Get off my back."

"I never said, 'You don't have something.'"

But you better come to the highest Authority, and he said, "*Come and stand beside me.*" And not one came. And he said, "*You're smarter than I thought.*" Because he said, "*See Lee, if they'd of come they'd of carried the first one out feet first,*" dead as a door-nail struck by the Pillar of Fire.

"Wow, Bro. Vayle, (you know) perish the thought."

Hey, do you believe this Message or why are you sitting here? You going to have a lot more fun someplace else. Sure. In a restaurant, beer parlor, pin-ball, dance hall, shooting squirrels, rabbits. Why sit in church? I'm not mean, just a question.

41. Now they looked at Balaam and Korah and their kind... Oh, we'll get through don't worry, I'm in no rush. You blame it on your preacher, he asked me to preach. He already told you people I was coming and likely would preach, then these spirits got on me and I said, "Well if I just feel good enough I'll do it." I don't even have to feel good to preach, it's just better if you feel good. What's feeling good got to do with it?

41. [Matthew 7:]

(15) Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing,
but inwardly they are ravening wolves. (See?)

(16) (You'll) know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns,
or figs of thistles?

(17) Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree
bringeth forth evil fruit.

Go back to the Garden of Eden, two trees, right? One brings Life, one brings death.

(18) A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree
bring forth good fruit. (That's proven in the Garden of Eden.)

(19) Every tree that bringeth (forth not) good fruit is hewn down, and
cast into the fire.

By their fruits you shall know them. In other words, what does the tree do to you? When you partake of the tree what's it do to you? It tells you, Cain partook of a tree, what did it do? Abel partook of a tree, what did it do? Moses partook of a tree, what did it do? Balaam partook of a tree, what did it do? Korah did it, what did it do? Took them all down to hell. Ah, come on, come on, come on. Let's understand these things.

(20) Not every one that saith, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom
of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

(21) MANY... [said loudly followed by a whistle]

Wow! MANY, Many, I thought, "Straight is the gate and narrow is the way and FEW, FEW there be..." [Mt 7:14] Now where's Pentecost?

Bro. Branham said, "*Methodist want the Baptist, Baptist want Presbyterian, Pentecostals want them all,*" and they got them. No Pentecostal can make the Rapture. Chaff, but they got gifts. Now come on... "Bro. Vayle I don't think I can take it?"

42. A woman over there in Norway, her husband's supposed to believe the Message, oh they hated me for coming over there, because they knew I wasn't like them. They tried to kick me out of the country, I went and argued ...?...

She said, "Sister Vayle, don't tell me these lovely Pentecostal women won't make it." And here this woman preached, she had arthritis so she cut her hair, she said she....

If my wife had arthritis and can't comb her hair, I'll either send her to a beauty parlor, or I'll comb it myself as long as my hands can work, or I'll pay somebody. Or say, "Honey, there's worse things than getting lice." [laughter] That's going to hell and burning with them.

No, no, no, no. Slacks, doesn't matter, these lovely Pentecostal women. Your Tammy Bakker's, she found a rich man, now they say she dumped poor Jimmy. Well, they're both for the dump as far as the Bible says.

43. [Matthew 7:]

(22) Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied
in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name
done many wonderful works?

(23) ... I never knew you: depart from me...

Excuses. Yeah. ...?... What's your excuse? And you won't dare lie. What about these Mohammedam's, these guys that saw Bro. Branham in India?

He said, *"Come on, in the name of your god make this man whole. Aha, (he said,) you're strangely silent. Come on, you Shiites and the rest of you, (most of them Mohammedans and Buddhists) come on, come on, come on."*

"Well," he said, "What if my God in the Name of Jesus makes him whole and his eyes come back?"

Oh, they took him up right now, but they never took him up with the understanding of truth, because in their hearts they believed in transmigration of souls, and they believed in the indwelling of God and all this other junk. Mohammadans are screwed up worse than Hogan's goat. Why? Abraham! That wasn't his wife Hagar. "Many more are the children of the desolate, than she that has a husband" [Isa 54:1] "Many will come in that day."

So they said, when the man was healed and they tried to grab Bro. Branham as though he had done it, and access to him would do it. Not looking to the True God and repenting.

44. You see, now on Judgment Day they'll come and the Lord will say, "Now didn't you know My servant William Branham?"

"Oh yeah, but our leaders they said different."

Let me ask you a question then, "Would you say any different now?" No they can't lie.

They'd have to say, "You've got us."

See they have to admit to Seed. This morning it's the same thing, because we're before the White Throne. What Seed are you? What Seed am I? It's not how great and how marvelous and what a great servant you are. It's like I heard a nice guy this morning on the air, and he just took it for a few minutes listening, he's doctor somebody from Buffalo here, very handsome guy and a nice meeting and he had this woman singing, and this man playing marvelous trumpet, they used to play for the world, they still do and don't know it. And she dressed up like a modified Tammy Bakker, very pretty, very svelte either ear bobs on and eyes so and so, and she said, "whoopee for Jesus, hallelujah." And he'd tootle his horn so nice.

The preacher doesn't have time to preach the Word so he gives a little illustration. And in the illustration he said, "Now," he said, about this poor boy dying, his father a multimillionaire and he wouldn't talk to his boy about the Lord and now the kid is dead. He got shot by a guy, bang, bang, bang, dies in his own blood. Put him in a casket, rich people come ...?... and the guy at the end of the funeral, he comes up with his foot and he said, he pulled God out of his pocket, a big roll of bills that represented all his money. He said, God he said, I'll give you my house and my millions, every single thing" he said, "let my boy have five minutes that I can talk to him about the Lord Jesus Christ."

And then the man said about the hollow voice in the lowest hell laughing, I've got news for you that preacher is just a Catholic trying to scare the people, the devil is not in hell. "So Bro. Vayle, you see a little thing like that shouldn't worry. It worries God. Yeah, that's the thing brother/sister, that's the thing." "Many will come in that day," it's too late.

45. Acts the 2nd chapter the Holy Ghost fell manifestation he said, "It's going to repeat at the end time." Sure.

Matthew 10, It tells you, "He sent them with power." Everyone with power, heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out devils, in My Name do wonderful things. "Freely you have received, freely give." And It said Judas the one that betrayed Jesus was there.

Then, Jesus in Jn 17:12, said, "I've only lost one which is the Judas son of perdition, and he was not one to begin with."

Now, back in the Book of 2 Thessalonians the 3rd chapter, the son of perdition is mentioned. So at the end-time just before the Great Tribulation the anti-Christ comes when everybody is prophesying and everybody has gifts, the ministry of the Son of Man Appears on the scene, and the same time the ministry of the son of perdition. In other words, anybody and everybody who names the Name of Jesus and it's a perfect scam and they don't know it. They can have miracle after miracle and signs and wonders, "and many more of their children than she that has a husband," And they'll out perform the same horse as the mule, there's no limit to what they'll do.

And in 2 Pet 2:15, and Jude 11, It tells you very succinctly that these men are patterned after Balaam and Cain, and especially Balaam, because they run free greedily for money due to the error that they have a gift that they can control and go to God and make Him change His Mind, and twist His arm. And Bro. Branham said, *"Prayer has one force and influence, not that you twist God's arm, not that you change God's Mind, but you stay there until God can change your mind."* And then he said, *"A right attitude toward any promise in your mind will bring it to pass."*

46. All right, we see there are two prophets, but there are two kinds of people. Yep. Two prophets but not two of a kind, they are different. Two kinds, and though they appear on surface to be the same wolf in sheep clothing, and they have many direct qualities which are admirable in both, there is only one prophet that is conceded to have the strength and the... correct connection with God, and that is the one who has the Word of God, who God has vindicated Himself to have been vindicated Himself to the people and they only come in certain junctures.

The others are only men with gifts, which can only be at times anointed with the power and not to the Word, and that's exactly where we stand. These people are anointed to the power, but not to the Word.

Now just a minute, where does your mind go when I make that statement? It goes right back to the devil. The devil is anointed to power but not the Word, because all power and authority is of God, and God delegated it to the devil. And He delegated It to Jesus who at that time was in the form of Michael, who both lead in the worship. And the devil said, "I'll take the power apart from the Word." And Jesus took the power with the Word.

47. Do you know why I believe the world is full of homosexuals? Do you know why I believe the world is the way it is? Bro. Branham said, *"When that baby kicking in its mother's womb and jumping muscles and nerves, and it is not truly alive (now concerning the flesh and the world, but remember the soul builds the house, because the life builds the house,) the baby drops from the womb, and a spirit comes in."* And he not just intimated, but specifically in one place talked of those being spirits of the fallen angels and the others that didn't fall. So what do you think is the spirit that's taken control of all these babies born in the last years, evil filthy spirits, because the seed has run out, and some are very religious. Women lesbians are now in the pulpit.

We thought it was bad when a certain woman who is a Lutheran decided to impress the people by worshipping God in a Lutheran church, and she stripped perfectly nude absolutely and there she did her dance and her hallelujah's worshipping God, of course her god is the devil.

Like old Aberhart [former premier of Alberta 1935-1943] fine old independent Baptist said, "You people that pray, Our Father which art in Heaven, had better be very careful because there are two in there." One is God, the other is the prince of the power of the air. You better know which one you're talking to. So she did her interpretive dance and the church said, "Beautiful." [Bro. Vayle claps] Yeah, filth. No wonder they ordain lesbian preachers.

Now, after this sermon if I talk a bit more, I don't expect Alphonse to feed anybody, because we'd all sooner puke then eat. Oh God does, He vomits, and just lukewarm gets Him upset. Because Bro. Branham said, "*The greatest lie in the world is ninety nine percent truth.*" You know I could preach this sermon this morning ninety nine percent and give you one percent and be a devil. "I don't believe it." For you sake and mine I sure don't believe it.

48. Now listen, now listen I'm going to close. You're all smiles and say thank God. But I want to leave you with the crowning thought that is really going to help you to get the truth.

There is a far cry from Mt 10:1 and 4-5, where He told the twelve to go out and heal the sick and raise the dead, cast out devils and Judas is specifically mentioned. And in 1 Cor 14:36 where he said, "If you are spiritual or a prophet you will believe this Word."

And Mt 7:15-23 where He exposes them to what they are in spite of their gifts. There is a far cry between all of those verses, and listen now, Matthew chapter what? Can you guess? Will you tell me what It is before I turn to It. It's in Matthew 16: "Who do men say that I the Son of Man am?"

And he [Peter] said, "Thou art the Christ the Son of the Living God."

And He said, "Blessed art thou Simon Bar Jonah, for flesh and blood have not revealed It unto thee, but my Father which is in Heaven. And I say unto thee that thou art a little rock, and upon this rock of revelation I will build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against It," except when they backslide.

"And on that **day** I say, "Hey who are you?"

"Lord, I'm one that cast out devils in Your Name, and I did wonderful works."

Is that what the Bible says? Huh? Then why do you try to make It say that when that would be a lie?

49. There is a far cry between a Balaam and a Pentecostal and the gifted people, that's all through the Bible and Matthew 16. "Flesh and blood have not revealed It, but my Father, and I'm building My Church."

That's why Bro. Branham said, "*You cannot worship and serve God apart from a prophet.*" The last day he said, "*The Elijah of this hour is the Lord Jesus Christ Himself, not a man, God, but It comes by a prophet.*"

Does God change His Mind about His Word? There isn't a chance. "So Bro. Vayle, then do I have to know all the Word?"

No, no sweet brother/sister, only the Word for this hour. Don't get mixed up like those Europeans, they said, "Oh, Bro. Branham made fifty three mistakes, you know." The great doctor

so and so over there in Germany, lives in adultery, now got a thousand people to preach to and teaches fornication and polygamy and all that stuff. "Oh, Bro. Branham made a mistake here. Oh, Bro. Branham didn't explain this."

50. Ah, shut up and sit down! You make me sick. Seducers of women, destroyers of men's souls. Preach what Bro. Branham preached, for there's a certain word for this hour and what belongs to Israel, keep your nose clean, keep your noses out of it. Shut up! We haven't even learned a tenth of what we should learn about ourselves, and now we want to talk about Israel.

People wasting their time about butterfly wings and they haven't got even a learning of the twenty percent of the human body that needs help. "Be as wise as serpents and as harmless as doves." [Mt 10:16]

"What came the Word of God out of you, or came It unto you only?" Where do we stand with Moses, Paul and William Branham? ...
