Seed of Discrepancy #44

Conforming to the Image Distorting/Bending the Word October 5, 1996

Let us pray. Heavenly Father, we are thankful for Your Presence, especially as we go back in our minds to the time when You indwelt Your Only-begotten Son Who came down here in the flesh that He might be the true tabernacle of Almighty God, and God perfectly manifest to us in this Son, Who is the very image of God. We do not want to forget that the prime reason that He gave forth a manifestation which was of You, proving that He was a vindicated prophet, was for the one specific purpose of the Word which was to come, which Word did come, and we saw the same in Paul, as the Word was brought forth, and Paul brought forth his vindication and proved that positively anyone who is a prophet or born of the Spirit would acknowledge that he had the utterance, Your utterance, for that hour.

And so today, Lord, with the same prophet in mind, the same type of minister, wherein You appeared to that person like Moses and Paul, in a particular, specific form, bringing us a vindicated Message, which the great ministry was for that one end, which was that true Message, and therefore, Lord, we know Your Presence is here for one particular purpose above all else, and that is to bring forth Your Word, that we may conform to You thereby, believing it as never before, and walking in that light as You are in that light, have fellowship one with another, and the Blood cleansing. Let that be our portion tonight, Lord. Help us to show the Word of God more perfectly as You help us. In Jesus' Name, we pray. Amen.

You may be seated.

1. Now, to date we've spent a great deal of time, approximately sixty hours, devoted, not to Bro. Branham's message as we usually do, word by word, but we have looked into many highways and byways scripturally that have come to our attention by using this Message as we would use the Bible. This is not only permissible, but necessary, for us because this is a last day Message for a last day people, namely we who believe a vindicated prophet to be the voice of God and the manifested Word of God in this hour to us according to Rev 10:1-7, 1 Th 4:16-17, Heb 12:25-29, Eph 1:17-23, 2 Pet 1:15-21, which is based on 1 Pet 1:10-12...all of these along with Acts 3:19-26 and Mal 4:1-6, which bring it together—not to forget to include Mt 12:13-21, which brings to pass Jn 14:12.

2. Now, we're going to look at all of those Scriptures which I simply read off in order to get this perfect understanding we have, and we've taken these byways different times, not leaving Bro. Branham's message "Seed of Discrepancy", but rather going into many, many facets, because when you study the seed of discrepancy, and you pinpoint it from where it began, the conditions, what it brings forth, and how it is bringing forth, you're literally detailing, really, the trail of the serpent and the serpent children, even as when you come into the true revelation of the Word of Almighty God and understand exactly how God moved and has moved and is moving, you begin to come into alignment with the trail of God. And you see it manifested in God's authorities, which is the Word giver, the prophet, and a five-fold ministry of this hour, and the people also included in it.

3. So, we spent roughly sixty hours so far, and most of that time has been spent on what we call these highways and byways, and we see it's very, very important to understand that this message of Bro. Branham's is actually the Word of God amplified in the sense of a marvelous outlining and what you might call a true revelation (In fact, you have to call it that: a true revelation.) as to what Paul brought forth and was not fully amplified in the Scripture here with some of the mysteries, even forgotten as to

what they really meant, or some of them which could only be revealed as they came to pass, as Bro. Branham said that *God reveals His Own Word by manifesting It*, or He interprets It also by manifesting It, which is His definite interpretation.

4. So, we have to look at this Scripture for this hour, and we see what lies there according to the Scripture and what lies there for you and for me who believe this Message by a vindicated prophet. Now of course, in Rev 10:1-7, you must notice that this is an interpolation. Many people try to read the Bible as though It had a complete chronological layout or an understanding. But the Bible does not deal specifically in chronology. It deals in revelation. That's why people could never understand why the Book of Genesis had Abraham going down to the Philistines, where King Abimelech was, and Sarah and he were going on to a hundred years of age, and he looked upon her and saw her being a beautiful young lady, and he desired her, therefore, that she would be his wife.

5. And right away the scholars said, "Well, you see now, that chapter shouldn't be there. That chapter should be way on the other side when they were young."

But unfortunately, the chronologist... Now, God's the chronologist. And Moses as a historian was merely a scribe, because Moses would not know, except by word of mouth, and that word of mouth would be pretty shoddy, because when you begin to hand things down by word of mouth you absolutely lose the true essentiality and intrinsicality of that particular story, not necessarily anecdote, but the real truth of what actually transpired.

So, they said, "Well, that's when they were young people."

It wasn't so. Brother Branham, by divine revelation, showed that they were both changed back to young children; well, not young children, but young man and woman, about nineteen and sixteen years of age.

6. And so, the Bible here has what we call 'a little something thrown in', something in parenthesis. It doesn't really belong in any particular place, it just stands there, and unless you know something that nobody else does, you're up a blind alley; you're guessing. Well now, we're not up a blind alley. We're not guessing, because you better believe when God speaks back to a man, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, that God is a God of integrity, and Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth and the life, and no man can come unto the Father but by me." He said, "The Father in me is speaking the words. The Father in me is doing the works."

7. So, if you believe that Bible, and you believe in the integrity of Almighty God—God cannot lie, and even our faithlessness all the more clearly shows His faithfulness, and everything we say and do is a lie compared to His truth and all, "Let every man's word be a lie, but let mine be true," said God—you could not get me to believe that God has lost His integrity and will back up a devil. Now, God will back up a devil in this way that He'll fulfill His Word concerning him, and one day we're going to see him thrown into the Lake of Fire and dissolved and annihilated, and that's good enough by me. But God does not lie. And He has a great integrity.

8. And so, when a prophet came on the scene with 'THUS SAITH THE LORD' and explained it, that there is a prophet on earth the same time this Mighty One comes down from heaven... Now, it doesn't take a genius and a scriptural giant, or much of a student, to realize the One that came down is the very One that sat on the throne in Revelation 4 and Revelation 5, because God Himself is the only One that has the rainbow. Because remember; God is the God of covenants. Man never went to God and said, "Lord, let's make a covenant." That's the biggest bunch of nonsense under high heaven.

When He said, "Come now and let us reason together," He was saying, "Sit down, and I'll reason with you and show you what the truth is, and you can take It." He didn't say, "Come on, let's get

together and talk about this thing and figure it out." What kind of a God would that be? Well, He'd be a democrat.

Well, we've got a democrat in office right now. That was a nasty remark, but he had it coming. He had it coming. A democrat in a democratic society trying to tell you that he's keeping the church and the state apart, and the state is telling women they can have abortions. If you want to kill a baby, take a life, go ahead. Now, we didn't know this before, we know it now. We know it now.

- 9. Now, here's the picture: [Rev 10:1]
 - (1) I saw another...(messenger) come down from heaven...

This time it's called a Messenger, not an angel per se, although you can call him the Angel of the Covenant, which simply means the Messenger of the Covenant, and God's His Own messenger with His Own covenant. As I said, when did man ever go to God and say, "Now, Lord, do it my way"? Moses went up there with the sacrifice offering of blood, and he stood there with the tables of stone. And God's finger wrote in those stones, and He didn't say, "Now, Moses what do you think of this? Hey, Moses, how will this suit the crowd? You know, Moses, you got an idea?"

Oh, come on. Dumbest thing in all the world. The messenger or the angel of the covenant speaks of God Himself.

10.	(1)	(He came) down from heaven, clothed with a cloud:rainbowupon
		his head,faceas it were the sun,feet as pillars of fire: (And you
		notice, Jesus comes. He's portrayed in an identical image, almost
		identical, in Revelation 1.)

- (2) He had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea... (and so on. But down in verse 7:)
- (7) But in the days of the voice of the seventh (messenger, a messenger from above comes down to the messenger below. When this messenger) shall begin to sound, (See?) the mystery of God should be finished...

What mystery? The "mystery of God as God hath declared the good news of the gospel," (That's the literal translation.) "shall be finished," shall be perfected; 'it's all over', completely drawn out, completely explained, completely right; all missing parts, all errors, corrected; finished.

(7) ...as he hath declared (the good news of the Gospel by his) prophets.

That's what God's doing. In other words, He comes down with His Own Word, even as It says identically in Acts 3, which I told you we would cover. You can see the very same thing there: God doing it. And how's He doing it? By a prophet. He tells you. He's never changed. That's why we'll see again Heb 13:8, exactly what It is; not what people think It is, but what God says It is.

11. So, all right. We're talking, then, in terms of the Message of this hour, that is literally the Bible. And so, we go to the Bible with the vindicated prophet and show you these things which we've shown you time after time.

Now, with this we also know that this, absolutely, is 1 Thessalonians 4: and get over here in verses 15-16, especially 16.

(16) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

(17) Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Now, that's a perfect Scripture there, where "The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit thou on my right hand.'" Absolutely we brought that to you many, many times. And remember; also, It tells you, "So shall we ever be with the Lord," and Bro. Branham categorically said that the sounding of the trumpet was the taking of the saints up, and he said at that time when that Spirit that's in our midst, which is God, becomes incarnate to us, we'll crown Him King of Kings and Lord of Lords, and that will be the Son of God, the Son of man, the Son of David, the Rose of Sharon, the Altogether Lovely, the One and All, which I think a man by the name of Dr. Stone found there's at least maybe four hundred and twenty different titles and names that God has that will be Almighty God.

12. This is identical to Hebrews. Now, we're talking about the prophet; we're talking about the Voice of God; we're talking about the prophet being the voice of Almighty God, or God using the voice of a prophet. And remember; in 1 Th 4:16, the Greek students will tell you It is not said to be the Voice of the One descending. What is it? It's the Voice of One descended, which is Rev 10:7. Revelation 10:1 comes down and 1 Th 4:16-17 spends all this time here with the Shout, Voice, Trumpet, taking us up.

Now, so therefore, that's Rev 10:1 coming down. And who's He coming down using the voice? The prophet. Because remember; God cannot ever change. It was His fearsomeness, and He knew what He was doing. And He's the One that put it in man's heart to say, "Moses, you go up there and talk to God." Now, he didn't tell them what to talk; he said, "You go and talk." Now, he said, "You come back and tell us what God said."

And God said, "That's fine. That's what we'll do."

And from that time on, God always used one man. He used that prophet. There's always a major prophet with the Word. So, all right.

13. Over here in Hebrews, we're looking at Heb 12:25-29.

(25) See that ye refuse not him that speaketh.

Now, just a minute; someone's speaking. Now, I want to ask the Baptists and the rest of the fundamentalists when the Bible got so complete that God didn't need prophets. Now, if He's still speaking, who's He going to speak to?

"Well, I've got the Holy Ghost. He speaks to my heart."

Then, how can eight hundred different people think eight hundred different thoughts on one measly little subject? You don't put God like a yo-yo, some vacillating creature like the Hindus' prayer wheels that go flying in the breeze. Forget it.

- 14. (25) ...refuse not him that speaketh. (He's talking.) For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more *shall not* we *escape*, if we turn away from him that *speaketh* from heaven: (So, all right. We've got Someone speaking from heaven.)
 - (26) Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.
 - (27) (But) this *word*, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken...

In other words, when He repeats what is already said, when He says It the second time, you better believe it's all over. So, God's going to speak from heaven. Now, who's He going to speak by? He's got to speak by a prophet. Now, people can say what they want. I don't care if he's the pope or anything else, or if he aggrandizes and makes himself some great somebody and talks about Fatima and all the great secrets the Virgin Mary's telling him. Hogwash, that's as bad as these guys and the female Holy Ghost, isn't it? You talk about a bunch of foolishness.

Now, He said, "The second time I do it, there's going to be a shaking, and this time everything's going to be shaking."

So therefore, we are in the process of a heavenly shaking because time and eternity blends. There's a thousand year period in-between, but you better believe, from this time on the course is set. It's going to happen. There's nothing going to stop it because it's already in progress. It's already past the point of the perpendicular and falling over, or falling up—whichever way. The divorce is finalized. In other words, the Bride and Groom are getting together for the exit—for the honeymoon, so to speak. All right.

- 15. (27) (...And that which remains then) cannot be shaken... (Now, watch.)
 - (28) Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:
 - (29) For our God *is* a consuming fire.

Now, when was He a consuming fire? He's certainly not a consuming fire right now, except in the sense that it's already set in motion. See? The consuming fire can only come at the time of the Judge: 2 Th 1:7-10. It can't come any other time. When you hear fire, it's always end time; it's not in-between. It's end time, signifying it's all over. He said, "I'm not going to touch the world with water once more, I'm going to vaporize it." So, there's fire in the offing.

16. Now, so therefore, God is speaking at the end time, just before the Great Tribulation that takes the Bride away, and all the events which follow, on down the line. This is identical to Ephesians, because this explains what it's all about. This gives you the understanding. You put these Scriptures together. Don't be afraid of Scripture. Just go to them with faith. Now he said, Eph 1:17.

- (17) That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: (That's God's Own revelation of God's Own Self.)
- (18) The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,
- (19) And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, (right up to the Resurrection and the Rapture, and the church being completely full now, the whole body of Christ, ready to come down on earth and reign with Him.)

17. Now, you've got over here in 2 Peter, continuing the same understanding that these things have to come to pass at the end time. You simply just don't walk away from them, as though you got some right to do it. In 2 Pet 1:15:

(15) Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance.

- (16) For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, (That's His Presence.) but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
- (17) For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- (18) And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.
- (19) (And) we have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts.

Now, in other words, what he saw back there was merely a type of what was to come, because Christ was not even dead and had not even been resurrected, and yet they saw him in a glorified manner. And so he tells you here that at the end time, he said:

- 18. (19) We have...a more sure word of prophecy; (which is the word of prophecy made absolutely sure to us. What was happened way back there was just a prophecy, but now it's going to be fulfilled.) whereunto ye do well to take heed, as a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:
 - (20) Knowing this first, that no prophecy of scripture is of any private interpretation.
 - (21) For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake *as they were* moved by the Holy Ghost.

Now, why do you think Peter hooked up a prophet with this scene? Now, why would he say that? Why would he say the Word is going to be made sure, and then, he starts talking about a prophet? If God's going to make His Word sure, don't tell me God needs a prophet. Or does He? Well, why would he mention a prophet? Why even talk of one? See? He's trying to tell you here, when this which took place back there in a vision and a type. When it became imminent, came into being in that hour, it would definitely take a prophet to let you know, even as Jesus was a prophet back there, letting them know, because you and I cannot know outside of a prophet.

19. Now, tell me: Who's going to raise up a prophet? Who's going to elect a prophet? Who's going to appoint a prophet? Who's going to set the qualifications in order to get a man like this, that's going to tell us about this?

Well, many say, "Well, I don't need anybody to tell me. I've got the Holy Ghost."

See, you know, big hollow up here. Trouble with people like that, they put their mouths in gear without even thinking, and that's not hard to understand because they've got nothing to think with. They've got nothing to think with—no spirituals; nothing at all spiritual.

You can train parrots. There's a parrot that's well-trained by a lady psychologist, and you say, "How many blue balls are there?"

He says, "Two." You can hear him say "Two blue balls."

How many pink?

"Three."

And he's right. You can get to ask the parrot questions. The parrot answers beautifully. Well, tell the parrot this. You might as well. You can't deal with animals.

You know at the end time the Bible says the human race is natural brute beasts, and science proves 99.99 at least are brute beasts? That's less than 0.01 out of five and a half billion people.

Now, let's go to Scripture. Five and a half billion people in the time of Noah; eight people made the ark. How many people are going to make it now? Well, there's not going to be many more. Five hundred? And a little group here a little group there go over a period of days? Five thousand, even? How many are dying off that believe this original, true Message. See?

20. Now, this Scripture here that we read in 2 Peter, I base It upon 1 Pet 1:10-12.

- (10) Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace *that should come* unto you:
- (11) Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.
- (12) Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them (which) have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

Now, It tells you right there, the Holy Ghost gave these prophets the thing to say, and they didn't even know what they were saying. They couldn't puzzle it; they couldn't put it together; they couldn't figure it. When it came to chronology, they were gone. Now, Peter's saying the same thing here. You won't know that time—you won't know about it, unless God has a prophet. Now, that's exactly what I see Peter is saying.

21. Is it possible, then, therefore, that Paul could have said things that Paul could not really place. It's maybe possible. He's just a prophet like anybody else. Could it be, then, that God would send a prophet on the scene in order to make these things clearer? You bet it is. That's exactly why he sent John the Baptist, merely to show that that One was present. And, if William Branham was called here for one purpose, to show that He was present, the next question comes up: why is He present? What is He doing? For whom is He doing it? What's all going to happen? Where does this take us? What's it all about? And that man better have all the answers. John the Baptist had the answers. The answer summed up beautifully: "Behold the Lamb of God that taketh away the sin of the world." Even when he said it, poor John didn't really understand the depth of what he was saying in that particular instance.

22. Now, along with Acts 3, this is one I told you we were going to look into, Acts 3:19-26.

(19) Repent ye therefore, (He says to Israel, "Change your mind.") and be converted, (change your minds, therefore, 'even' be converted. That's a preposition as well as a conjunction.) that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.

And Bro. Branham categorically said, "*That was the great healing revival*." And he categorically said, "*There's not such thing as a true healing revival unless there's a change of Message, a new Message*."

So, all right. At this time there's got to be a change of Message in the understanding that the Message will be for the very hour in which those people are living. So therefore, there's got to be a prophet here, or forget it. Because we read Peter, now you've got in the mouths of two witnesses. See? You've got Peter telling it, and you know that all through Scripture we have the very same understanding of one prophet agreeing with the other, showing the things of Almighty God, just knowing they're of God, not knowing everything about Him. Now, so, if Paul comes on the scene, and he says the same thing that Peter says, which he does in a different way, positively, and you find that Malachi's already said It previously, right down the line, these prophets, then, have to be on that scene.

23. Now, notice in verse 20:

- (20) And he shall send Jesus..., which before was preached unto you (or 'appointed' unto you:)
- (21) Whom the heaven must (retain... Not 'receive'. They've already received Him; 'retain' Him.) until the (restoration. That's not 'restitution'; it's 'restoration'.) of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

Now, just a minute. We took that the other day to show you in 1 Corinthians 14, concerning Paul, when he said, "If any man thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, full of the Holy Ghost, let him acknowledge the things that I write unto you, that is, the utterances which I have put down for you, the utterance of Almighty God."

So, when you're talking of that, (all things spoken by the mouth of all the holy prophets) you're talking about all the utterances that came forth from the mouths of these people—not their mentality, not their heart, not their soul, no part of them, but the Word altogether in their mouths. He's showing us it's a pattern that God uses, the prophet is the mouthpiece of God; he is the Voice of God.

24. So, It says here, the restoration of every utterance of God. Now, watch where you go.

(21) ... which God has spoken...

It tells you what it is. So therefore, there would be almost a redundance there, but it isn't redundant. The 'restoration of the utterances', which is 'that which has been uttered'.

(21) (Those utterances,) which God (uttered,) by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

Now, watch.

(22) For Moses truly said... A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.

Now, let's get a picture here, right off the bat. What the people asked Moses for was already in divine order, but it had not been instituted to a group of people to know that God was going to deal with them on the grounds of which He wanted to deal with them as the seed of Abraham. Always it was like one person. Now we're dealing with the bunch.

25. Therefore he goes back and he says... Now, you got to back since the world began.

(22) For Moses truly said...

So, Moses wasn't there when the world began. He was there hundreds and hundreds of years later in the human race. So, what's he doing? He's quoting God. So now watch, you start with Moses the great historian. You start with Moses to show Deuteronomy 18 and Numbers 12. "There's a prophet in the name of the Lord, the thing will come to pass, but my servant Moses, it is not so; like the prophets I speak in dreams and visions, but I will speak to him face-to-face, or even apparently, not just in dreams and visions." 'Even apparently' means 'just like that Pillar of Fire right there above the prophet's head'; 'I'm going to be right there visible to him in some particular way'.

Now, Moses is the one that God used to bring this to the people. "People, you are going to have to have a prophet between you and me," God speaking. Now, Moses said it, but it was in vogue from the very beginning, God dealing and bringing His Word through a man.

26. Now It says:

- (22) ...the Lord your God raise up (a prophet) unto you of your brethren, like unto me; and him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.
- (22) And it shall come to pass, *that* every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

Now, that did not happen when Jesus was on earth. But you see, it's going to happen. And this means utter destruction; it means utterly destroyed from among the people. Now, when's it going to happen?

27. Now, keep reading.

(23) Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel...

Now, notice; he leaves Moses who was the one that said it, the one that went way back in history by Almighty God teaching him the true history. Now, he swings right to Samuel. Notice that Bro. Branham always went to Samuel; never to Moses, although he was one in the frame like Moses also. But he went to Samuel. Why? Because he did not have a ministry of bringing the original Word; he had the ministry to reveal the original Word. And notice:

(24) ...(all) that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days.

What days? The days that we're talking about right now, of which in the last days, two days, His Spirit upon all flesh, from those two thousand years, that's going to cap it, that's going to end it, because the Millennium's coming on the scene. Just when, we don't know. But it will be here. See?

28. (24) Ye are the children of the prophets...

Now, that's the stupidest thing in all the world to tell a bunch of people they're the children of the prophets if he doesn't mean to bypass the flesh and let them know they are children of the prophets by reason of the Word of God, because the prophets did not inseminate enough women to bring forth all of Israel. In fact, how many prophets were there? So, children would be the born ones, born of the Word, those that come up under the covenants of Almighty God. Now:

(25) ...of the prophets, and the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

29. Now, watch.

(26) Unto you (Jews) first God, having raised up his Son, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

When did God raise up Jesus to the Gentiles? As far as I know, not until this last age, as Bro. Branham said, "God was obligated to do in this age what He did in the flesh of Jesus Christ when He walked in Israel, in Palestine." And that's exactly what Matthew 12 tells us. It took me a long, long time to find where Bro. Branham could have the ability to say, "Hey, God's obligated."

Now, understanding, then, there will be a prophet at the end time, because you simply cannot deal with God—Him dealing with the people rather—except there be a prophet to bring the Word of God, and also reveal the Word of God, as Bro. Branham said so correctly, *a prophet is not necessarily and so much a forth-teller as he is a revealer*. And frankly for you and me that's a wonderful thing that he was.

30. Now this, of course, in our day is Mal 4:1-6, which is the last chapter in the last Book of the Old Testament Bible.

(1) For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, ...it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Does that sound like there's going to be a perpetuation of people upon earth by natural means? No way, shape, and form. They're going to get burned up. They won't be there. It says neither root nor branch. No way.

- (2) But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; (He said, "*That's the Rapture, the time of the Rapture*.") and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.
- (3) And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do *this*, saith the LORD.... (That's Revelation, when they come back.)
- (4) Remember ye the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb (That's Deuteronomy, the Word twice-given.) for all Israel, *with* statutes and judgments. (Notice: statutes, judgments.)
- (5) Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: (before that day when it's all burnt up)
- (6) And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. (Part of that was fulfilled in John the Baptist; the second coming up under Bro. Branham.)

31. Now, this includes, as we said, Matthew 12, because these prophets must be vindicated. If the man is going to come from God, God's got to be on the scene to vindicate. Now, let's face it, Rev 10:1-7, except for the time, and except for the content of what is to transpire in a certain period of time, which is designated in Rev 10:1-7, especially verse 7, God never fails to come down and deal with the people in a prophet. As Bro. Branham said, *"When you see God descend from the heavens and stand before groups of men and declare Himself as ever He did."* And that's exactly what he said in the Rapture tape [message], and Bro. Branham stood right there, God having come down from heaven to declare Himself to the people, and they went away completely confused.

32. And I had a great loyalty to Bro. Branham, but when he said, *"The Shout is the Message,"* I told you what my thinking was: "Brother Branham, you said a lot of very peculiar things, but this is the most peculiar I've ever heard. I don't know that I can take it."

And I heard my instant response from my heart say, "When was he ever wrong?" I said, "Shout is the Message."

That did it. That's all I needed to do was say, "Shout's the Message." Today I understand absolutely. I believe from Scripture, absolutely, one hundred percent the way it should be, which is God putting His Church in order to get them out of here. We'll see this before the night's over, if we've got time. See, I'm just trying to get wound up here in the basics.

33. Now, Matthew 12, he tells you distinctly there at the end time what's going to happen, and It says verse 17, that the prophecy of Isaiah is going to be fulfilled.

(18) Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.

When did he ever do it? Never did it. They're going to tell you he did, but they're liars. He never did it. Now, listen what It says, when he does:)

(19) He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear his voice in the streets.

Hogwash. That took place back there in Israel. He strove; he cried; they heard his voice; he lifted up his voice in Jn 37-39. He screamed out, "Ho, everyone that thirsteth," you know. "This spake ye of the spirit." He beat them up and threw them out of the temple. Every one of those things he did.

(20) (The) bruised reed (he won't) break, (He sure did...the) smoking flax he (won't) quench, (He sure did, but notice:) till he send forth judgment unto victory.

Tells you right there, at the end time. Now, listen. Let's get this flat. Who did the works? God did. Who's God? The Father of the Lord Jesus Christ. And yet let's understand It. The Scripture says Jesus of Nazareth, who went about doing good, who healed all that was sick and afflicted of the devil. Who did it? God did it. Who'd He do it through? Jesus. So, who did it? Jesus did it. The same thing as It says, "Lay hands upon the sick, and they shall recover." Whose hands? Your hands; my hands. Who does the healing? God does it. So, Who's going to do it here? God.

You can't change It and say, "Well, oh, God gave a dispensation to Jesus, now hallelujah."

Listen; shut up with your stupid hallelujahs. You can go to hell with what you think is a holy smirk on your face, and you'll end up in the pit. Don't you try to make Jesus God. He's not God. He's the Son of God.

34. And so much for David Temple and his ilk who said, "Lee Vayle's preaching two gods," because I quote William Branham, now there's two of them. I never said there was two gods. William Branham never said there were two gods. There were two personalities standing there!

Now, if you don't get that, you better smarten up around me kid, or I'll feed you to the lions. I can stand so much but only so much. Or don't bother talking. Do you think I'm going to go to...could have gone to Einstein and discussed the form of energy? All I can read is there's an E with a square or something over it, and that takes care of it. That's supposed to mean energy. I don't know, what is it? Russell, you know more than I do, Rusty. Oh you don't... if you don't know just keep your mouth shut.

35. (21) And in his name shall the Gentiles trust.

And Bro. Branham said, *"The name of God is the Word revealed."* So, what are you trusting in? See?

Now, which brings to pass Jn 14:12. What's Jn 14:12? The one who does the 'greater works'. Now, who's going to do the greater works? The one that believes.

Now, just a minute. That could be anybody then.

You say, "I'll believe."

What if you don't believe right?

Now, if you're going to do greater works, you've got to believe like Jesus believed. And you'd better have that kind of connection so you can believe like Jesus believed. "What I hear my Father say, I know and I repeat. What I see my Father do, I get visions, and I do it."

What was Jesus? He was a prophet.

You say, "Well, he's the Savior."

Oh, come on. Listen; don't just get things messed up and be smart with your tongue. He was that prophet, and without being that prophet, he could never be a savior because he had no vindication whatsoever without it. Let's understand a few things. Sure he's the prophet, you bet. And he never changes, either. He's the prophet-king because he's the anti-type of the type David, prophet-king—the great high priest, based upon Melchisedec, very supernatural.

36. As these verses are perused, one simply cannot delete Rev 3:20-22, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock, and if any man hear my Voice, 'any man' open the door, I'll come in and sup with him and he with me." You see?

...which is amplified (Now, that's the end time, the last church age.) which is amplified by James 5. Now, watch what It says in Jas 5:1-9.

(1) Go to now, ye rich men, weep and howl for your miseries that shall come upon *you*.

So, it's prophetic. At that time when the miseries come:

(2) Your riches (will be) corrupted, ...your garments motheaten.

Well, if their garments are moth-eaten, the moths ate them up; they ain't got no garments, have they? So, they're part of the miserable, naked crowd, and they don't even know it—like the Jews are today. They've got all the paper; doesn't do them a nickel's worth of good. Hitler... And now they, are trying to get the gold and jewels back in Switzerland. I don't think they're going to succeed too much. They claim there's billions there that the Jews secreted before Hitler wiped them out, took them to the gas chambers and so on. Now they're trying to put pressure on the Swiss to open up their banks. Ha, ha, ha. I just laugh. I've got no faith in the Swiss or anybody else.

37. I've got faith in my Bible. It says:

(3) Your silver and (your) gold's corrupted; ...the rust (Notice; they're rusty.) shall be a witness against you, and eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days.

All the money, all the gold, all the silver, all the paper is coming together in these filthy merchants. Now, who's the filthy merchant? Revelation 17 and 18: Babylon.

(2) Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, (There's your pension funds, everything else, gone.) crieth...

...your social security. Oh, the government's very nice. All the money poured into social security is nowhere. There's a nice little note written there, "We've got this money, and we the government owes this to this fund, so we'll keep pouring in the fund."

There's nothing to pour in. "Wretched, miserable, naked, don't even know it." The whole government. They say they're six trillion in debt. I heard sixteen trillion. You've got to get some of these right wing papers to really get a little bit of the truth. They're a little bit too far fetched for me, but at least you can balance it.

38. Hey, they finally found out that Ruby did fly from Mexico to Havana. Kenny Goff knew that years and years before Kenny died, and Bro. Branham knew Ruby was behind it all in the syndicate, because that's what God told him and showed him. Hey, I'm glad we knew a prophet, and I'm glad we know the God of the prophet.

39. Now, It says:

- (4) ...which...you kept back by fraud, crieth: ...the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of (the harvest).
- (3) Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton...

That's your big CEO's today, their golden parachutes and everything else. And the government cracked down for awhile. It was under Carter, wasn't it? He limited the cocktails they could have, so you wouldn't go back to your office drunk or something.

(5) ... ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.

How do you 'nourish your hearts for the slaughter'? Huh? We'll talk about that. You'll catch it, I hope, before we get through tonight.

(6) Ye have condemned *and* killed the just; *and* he (did) not resist you.

Yeah, who took care of Hoffa? Who took care of a lot of guys? Wasn't the guy Rockefeller brought in, the soldiers, the American army on flatcars and shot down the miners, because he wanted to bust the union? Come on, who knows history? Anybody except me? I'm not even a Yankee. And I know more than you people sitting here? My God, where have you been? Anybody know who the... Oh, who are those guys now...Quakers, you know the old Quakers. Not Quakers, who are they, John? The pilgrims... What are they called again? Puritans. Who knows who the Puritans are? Good. You know the Puritans had the purest doctrine and perhaps were the greatest people on earth when it came to real spiritual matters and all. I want to ask you a question now. Who left Plymouth Rock to come to America? Who was it? Puritans. Now, why did they come? Was it because of corrupt government? No. Roman Catholic prosecution and persecution.

40. Now, what do the Catholics say, even before Bro. Branham died, in the text books in Florida? The people in England who left Plymouth to come to America, left because of despotic government, and they brought Catholic priests to teach them religion. You don't believe me? I'll get the name of the woman that taught the school and had the textbook and wouldn't use it. That's what they call revisionism. That's why God is female. If women are so smart, and this is so smart, how come women are calling men just

sperm donators? Because they ain't got life themselves. And I'm not a chauvinistic pig standing up here for one minute.

41. Let's keep reading.

(7) Be patient..., brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. (That's His Presence again.) Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

Joel, teaching rain, prophet in the last day, sows the seed of the entire Bible from the serpent in the Garden of Eden to the prophet in the former rain.

- (8) Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh.
- (9) Grudge not one against another, brethren, (Don't waste your time fussing each other.) lest ye be condemned (or judged): behold, the judge standeth (at) the door.

How many doors are there at the end time? One door. Call it two if you want; there's one. Who's standing at the door? "Behold, I stand at the door and knock." And who is He? He's the Judge. And you can't get by it, because they're both there for the end time, and the end-time gathering together positively is the great harlot system which controls and owns everything, and they do it by reason of the gold.

42. Okay. This takes us directly to Gen 18:1-33, which is the Judge—Abraham outside the tent, Sarah in the tent, God standing there. He says, "Where is Sarah, thy wife?"

"She's in the tent behind you." (in the tent)

"Well," He said, "this time next year Sarah will have a baby boy."

And Sarah laughed. He said, "Sarah, why did you laugh?"

She didn't even laugh out loud. Brother Branham said *she laughed up her sleeve*, but there must have been in a hole in the elbow, or God heard it crackling around the seams. He said, "Why are you laughing?"

"I didn't laugh."

"Oh yes, you did laugh."

Now, there's the faithfulness of God. He didn't say, "Well, I'm going to revise my covenant." Brother Branham explained it: she was Abraham's wife. He'd have had to kill Abraham, then, too. Couldn't kill a part of Abraham. She was a part of him.

So, that's your Judge. And that time Abraham said, "Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?" And remember; it's just before the burning, Sodom and Gomorrah type, that the Son of man reappears on the scene. All of this, the Judge, everything, opens up. Because remember; just Lot was down there. He was the foolish virgin. But God was with the elect, Abraham and Sarah, back.

43. Now, this brings us directly to 2 Thessalonians 1. Why? Because you can link all of these things up. There as simple as A-B-C. So, It says:

- (7) And...you who are troubled rest with us, (That's relax.) when the Lord Jesus (Christ) shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty (messengers),
- (8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: (You could even say 'even they that do not obey'.)
- (9) Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, (It doesn't say when; it just says they're going to be.) and from the glory of his power;
- (10) When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and...be admired in all them that believe (because (of) our testimony among you...) in that day.

Now, here we see Paul is using the very words of Luke, when Jesus spoke in Luke 18.

- 44. Now, Luke 18, we have the parable, verse 1:
 - (1) And he spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
 - (2) Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:
 - (3) And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary.
 - (4) And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;
 - (5) Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest...her continual coming she weary me. (So, just get her out of my hair and give her what she wants. Who cares? I don't have any business with anybody anyway. I'm not afraid of man or God, yet because this widow troubles me, I'll avenge her.)
 - (6) And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.
 - (7) ...shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?
 - (8) I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when (a) Son of man comes (to do it,) shall he find faith on the earth?

All right. Now, the word 'avenge' means 'to vindicate and carry out justice'. Now, it's the judge doing it. So, the judge is going to vindicate and carry out justice. Now, the judge cannot carry out justice unless he rewards the righteous and condemns the unrighteous. There is no way that he cannot bypass that which is good without commending them and, also, to judge that which is discrepant. See?

45. Now, look at verse 8.

(8) I tell you...he will avenge them speedily. (...which he does. But he also says here:) Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on...earth?

Now, Son of man is, of course, definitely the prophet. Now, if you have a Scofield Bible, (And I looked this up myself to make sure.) you'll find that Scofield actually tells the truth when this Scripture has been translated, that the word 'faith' is not your own personal faith. It doesn't have a thing to do with that. It has to do with the body of truth which is the true Word of God in Its revealed form. It's the truth that came from God to the prophet and comes through a five-fold ministry to bring the church to perfection.

46. Now, remember that perfection is not the Blood of Christ that perfects. You've got two perfections two things that perfect. You've got the Blood, and you've got a five-fold ministry, which bring the Word. They're two different things. One is something God has done for you that you accept because you're a child of God; you repent; the Blood, then, allows the Holy Spirit to come. From that point on there is a growth. And that growth will come to the place Bro. Branham showed, more and more to 'perfection', which means 'the conclusion', when you become a true adult and mature Christian.

47. So, the thing is, he's talking about the 'body of revealed faith', even as It says, "The faith which was once for all delivered to the saints," as Jude tells it, which means the body of truth as has been brought, divinely revealed and divinely taught, so that we understand it.

Now, in here he says, "Shall he find faith?"

Well, look; Paul tells you that in Acts 20. He said, "You're going to start moving away now, and going to move a lot of people with you."

Then, in 2 Corinthians 11, he tells them the same thing. He said, "Already you've got a false Jesus, a false gospel, and a false spirit. Already you're on the way out, and you're going down and down and down."

48. Now, in here what I want you to notice when I read in 2 Th 1:7-10, that we are seeing here, the twin or two vines, or blessing and cursing, right hand/left hand, parallelism of Scripture. Now, this is what I'm leading up to here, particularly, and showing you about a vindicated prophet. That he's the one who taught always, *"Notice, they're twins."* Never, never, never, never, never anything but twins. No way. Right in the Garden of Eden: Knowledge of Good and Evil/Tree of Life, Tree of Life/Tree of Death, all the way down, Cain and Abel. You simply cannot get rid of twins. So, even if only one is mentioned the other twin has to be there. God does not have only one hand. Now, He may only use one hand, but He's got two hands. See? He's got two eyes; He's got two feet.

49. So, Deuteronomy 11 and 27 (both) tell of Mount Ebal and Mount Gerizim, where on Mount Ebal are the cursings; on Mount Gerizim are the blessings. The negative and the positive, left hand/right hand; you cannot get away from it. There are your twins.

Now, Matthew 25 also talks about twins. And here's where we get the left hand and the right hand. These are the sheep that are separated from goats. Now, as sheep and as goats... It doesn't say they are. It says, "As a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats..." On the right hand, he says, "Come into the blessings of my Father." On the left hand, he says, "You're cursed, and you go to destruction." So, God stands there left hand/right hand, blessing/cursing. Always you've got the two. You cannot get away from it.

50. Now, notice the twins in 2 Thessalonians 1. You see, first of all, there's a seed of discrepancy.

- (8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God... (But previous to it:)
- (7) You who are troubled (relax) with us, when the Lord...shall (come)...

"You that aren't troubled, but are the troublemakers, you look out when He comes with flames of fire." Then he goes down again to the other seed. You've got seed of discrepancy; you've got the seed of conformity. You can't miss; they're both there. They are both talked about: those that will come into relaxation, the seed of God; those that are heading for judgment and destruction, because they will receive it, according to Mal 4:1-6.

Now, there are two different seeds, the seed of discrepancy, positively, is one of a twin. Now, I'm looking at him before I look at the other. No, I'm going to change my mind. I'm going to look at the seed of conformity.

51. Now, the seed of conformity is over here in Heb 1:3.

(3) Who (That's Jesus, the Son, who) being the (effulgence, the outraying,) of *his* glory, the express image of his (substance), and upholding all things by the word of his power...

Now, we find right here that Jesus, absolutely, being an image, he would positively conform to the original because, if you are an image, you will be in confirmation with what the image was taken from. Right? Well, that's the truth. There's no two ways about that.

52. So, all right. This we find in Romans 8, and we read It the other day. Here's one of your twins. And we're talking about us, not Jesus now. Verse 28:

- (28) We know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
- (29) For whom he did foreknow, he did (also) predestinate *to be* conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

All right. Now, what does the word 'conform' mean? It means 'jointly formed'. And didn't Bro. Branham say *the only difference between us and Jesus, the way we came, was that he remembered his pre-existence and we did not*? Well, he said it, didn't he? He certainly did. So, they're jointly formed.

53. Now, notice what It says, this joint forming is in order that He might be the firstborn of many others just like him, of many born ones. So, if you've got a firstborn, you've got a three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, till it all runs out. But he's the first one, and as the first one, he's the preeminent one, and he's got to be a Son. Get this flat: He's got to be a Son, because he receives the inheritance of His Father. In case His Father dies, he gets it all. And if the Father doesn't die, the Father has the right to give him fifty percent, and the Son has the right to claim the fifty percent. As Bro. Branham said, *his name is just as good on the check as his Dad's*.

Conform... Now, God wants all kinds of sons and daughters, or born ones, to be a chip off the old block, because they literally are a chip of the life of God, because all that God was, that He wanted bodily, He poured into Jesus. And we were all in him. They put it in Adam, and as in Adam all die, all those in Jesus come back by the sacrifice, the Blood falling; the life coming upon them, they get set for glory. And it's all grace. So, you see the conformation there. What we're looking at.

54. Now, let's talk about the other twin, much as we don't like to. He is the seed of discrepancy. Now, let's just take a look at these discrepant, decrepit, and discrepant ones. What do I want? 2 Corinthians 11. Let's take a look at them.

Now, Paul is speaking of those that have polluted the Gospel, taken His message, another Jesus, another gospel, another spirit. How far can you get wrong? That means as God is perfect in three, (Jesus, true Gospel, and His Spirit) the devil is now made perfect in three. As God is good, he's evil. As God is

righteous, he's unrighteous. As God is full of grace, he's full of disgrace. He's in three, just like we have. You have the Holy Spirit came down, a five-fold ministry, and you've got a Bride. Now, watch these 'birds'. In verse 13:

- (13) For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.
- (14) And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

He's an apostle! He's a preacher! He's a messenger! He's a priest! He's a pope! He's a Presbyter, an elder! Oh yeah, he's right in there, religious, right up to the teeth and the eyeballs.

(15) Therefore *it* is no great thing if his ministers be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; (They're hypocrites.) whose end shall be according to their works.

Now, where do you hear about works except over there in Matthew 7? Because he's talking about these buzzards: "Many will come in that day and say, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name, in Thy Name done wonderful works, in Thy Name done wonderful deeds?"

He'll say, "I never knew you."

Now you hold this in mind, because I'm going to blast it out shortly. [Bro. Vayle talks about time left and how he's going to finish.] Okay.

55. Now, the seed... Number one: You saw these birds here that I'm talking about? The seed of discrepancy? Their testimony is a testimony of the devil, and they transform themselves by that word that has been polluted and denigrated. Oh, they turn out to be wonderful people, kind old priests, everything else. Now, 2 Th 1:8:

- (8) In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- (9) Who shall be punished with...destruction (That's your first bunch. Notice your second; they're down here in verse 7.)
- (7) You who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord (comes)...
- (10) (Because he's going to come to you and me) to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.

That means Paul's gospel has to come back to the perfection that Paul had it when he delivered it. Right? Because It says, "in that day." How can you believe something two thousand years old that's got a false Jesus, a false word, and a false spirit? You've got to get back to the true Jesus, the true God, and the true Gospel: Father and His Son, and the Word!

56. Now, tell me there's two gods I'm preaching. But you know something? Oh, they'll hear a voice, like one guy heard a voice, "Yeah, Lee Vayle's wrong."

In 1962, the prophet said, "*Lee, I knew you'd be back, that's because you're seed.*" You do what you want about it. I'd sooner hear William Branham, who said, "*That's vindicated.*" That man was no liar. My sister read his handwriting. There wasn't any deceit in the man's hand. Get this flat: do you understand what I'm saying? No deceit. Look in your hearts tonight. I'll look in mine. How much deceit have we got? Merciful God, I hope you don't tell on me, and I won't tell on you. [Laughter] Yeah.

Now, notice in verse 8, they know not God to be destroyed by God's vengeance, same time He avenges us, and they obey not the Gospel, and their end is to be burned. That's no two ways about that. And in verse 9, you've got destruction everlasting, but in verse 10 we see the good ones, which are, as we mentioned, the seed of Almighty God, and they will conform to the Lord without any doubt whatsoever. Now, notice in verse 8, the serpent seed does not know God.

57. Now, that's something here that you notice is very strange in Romans 1. It says here:

(18) The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness [in] men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness.

They actually are identified with the Word that they do not actually believe in. Now, It says here, in verse 21:

(21) Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain...

Now, there was a time when they knew. There was a time when they knew, and then, they fell away from It. And when they fell away from It, they bred successive generations, and the devil just kept coming in and confusing them and turning them around into a horrible condition.

Now, let's just take a look at that thought there: "They knew God. They know not God." Now, one time they knew God, and they left Him. Now, how can this generation (taking Romans) belong to this hour: we've got a people that know not God—because that's what It says in 2 Thessalonians. We're not talking now way back in Paul's day; we're talking about this day—this very day. And Paul said now, "They knew Him, and they wouldn't keep on knowing Him."

58. Now, let's watch this. The word 'know' in the Greek is not what you think it is. It's 'to see and be aware of God'. Now, tell me, could you sit in William Branham's meeting and not be aware of God? If you say you could, then you are even worse than the devil. If you could sit there and see that, and not know it was God in the apostle Paul...Right?...and in Moses and the prophets and the apostles, it shows you saw Him, but you didn't see Him to know Him and really receive that that was God. And yet they have to say, "That's got to be God."

Now, at Bro. Branham's eulogy, when they had that in Tucson, Perry Greene, I guess, is the one that had it, or Billy Paul did; might have been Phoenix. Tommy Osborne preached, and he said, "We saw God."

He's right. But he didn't. Because; the next thing is: they are aware, but really not aware, and they do not obey.

Now, the word 'obey' is a strange word in the Greek. It means to 'hear (h-e-a-r) under'. You 'hear under', which means 'you hear as a subordinate'. So, if you're a soldier, you; obey. What do you obey? You obey the word that you hear, and you place yourself under it.

59. Now, let's go to 1 Th 4:16.

(16) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout...

The Keleusma, and I'm not pronouncing that right, I suppose. There's different pronunciations, and who cares? But it's a military command! So, these people can see God, they can know it is God, they can write a book, <u>A Man Sent from God</u>, they can call him a prophet, and they still see God, but they don't see God, and they don't obey God! Because they say, "Bless God, we've got some, too."

Well, I'll tell you, I can bake a cheesecake, but don't expect me to stand beside Julia Childs. I might make something that passes for a horrible French concoction as a sauce, but don't ask me to stand beside Julia Childs. But these people have no problem blasting me. And comparing themselves, and making themselves something, in the presence of the Almighty, because the prophet is God to the people, whether they want it or not. Now, that's a hundred percent the Scripture.

60. So, this is the Shout. Again in verse 9, this is the group who are twice dead, as It says in Malachi, "leaving neither root nor branch," uprooted, twice dead. As Bro. Branham said, *leaving neither root nor branch shows there's no such thing as eternal hell.* He put it right at the White Throne, and believe me, this hour is no different from the White Throne, because it **is** the White Throne, because the Judge is here! Now, come on. Is there a second God from whom the heavens and earth flee away? Oh. this One, shall I try to placate Him, and say, "Surely, you're not the One in Revelation."

"Oh, yes I am." That's Elohim, Jehovah-Elohim. See?

61. Now, It says in verse 10 that, at the time of this great Presence, this One that comes down—because He does come down—Christ, will be both glorified and admired. And the word 'glorified' means 'splendid', 'noble', 'gorgeous'. My Bible tells me He's the Altogether Lovely. What will you compare Him to? The second word 'admired' is 'held in admiration', 'marveled at'. Then verse 10 talks about the Lord Jesus Christ being greatly admired because we know Him now as we've not known Him previously, He's been revealed to us. So, watch, then, the seed of discrepancy in verse 9. [2 Thessalonians 1]

(9) ...punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord...

Now, watch: "Depart from me; I never knew you." That's White Throne. Is it any different in this hour? No, because this is the hour they're doing all these miracles and everything wonderful. Already they are judged, because Bro. Branham put us at the White Throne. And he said, "*I indict this generation*." He brought us right in the presence of what we are looking at this very evening, and they were also the seed of God there and the seed of discrepancy, and no doubt there was foolish virgin as part of that seed, which we don't know too much about. We just have to leave that be. Brother Branham explained it, and that's as far as we can go. And so therefore, we see in verse 9, that particular destruction is already foretold exactly as it must come to pass.

62. Now, also in the seed of conformity there'll be, as I said, those in whom Christ is glorified. Now my point is this: if you can see Almighty God, and know, 'Hey, that's beyond man, that's God,' or whatever you want to call it, 'that's it,' and you refuse to accept the truth of Deuteronomy 18, Numbers 12—this is God with a Message and I'm using a man to do it, then where do you stand before Almighty God in the hours which are coming? The only thing we can look forward to is a fearful judgment at the wrath and indignation of Almighty God, because we have not listened to Him Who is here.

Now, they'll say "He's here;" they admit He is here, but they'll want to put Him in everybody, or they'll say, "Well, He's always been here."

See, they can't put it together! And they're not going to put it together! Because the Bible says they can't! Well, the Bible doesn't say that. The Bible says they're the ones that can't see Him and can't obey. They're the seed of discrepancy, no matter how you look at it. So evidently, the only very elect are those in 1 Th 4:16, who hear the Shout. And the Shout is Matthew 24, which is the light returning from the east to the west and, then, going back again.

63. Now, also note that even as God is glorified and admired in the Bride, (That comes from Ephesians 1 where God Himself comes down.) and then, you watch in [2 Th 2:2-3. I'll try to make this as clear as I can, though sometimes it's not that easy. It says here:

(3) Let no man deceive you by any means: for *that day shall not come*, except there come a falling away first, (the) man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition...

Now, what is that great day? It tells you right here there is going to be what? The destruction. And then, on top of that, even before it, there's going to be the taking away of the Bride. Now, watch what It says in verse 1 [chapter 1].

(1) Now we beseech you, brethren, *by* the (presence) of our Lord Jesus Christ, and *by* our gathering together unto him...

Now, how did Jesus say they're gathered? They're gathered by prophets, wise men, and scribes. They're gathered by the Word. And Bro. Branham said, *"They're gathered by the Message."* "The Lord Himself shall descend" (Remember.) with a military command. He's going to do it. Now, that Word comes by the prophet.

- (2) That ye soon not be shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, (In other words, don't get pulled away by another spirit or another gospel; you just listen carefully.) as that day of (the Lord) is at hand.
- (3) Let no man deceive you by any means: for *that day shall not come*, (That doesn't say that, 'for the day cannot come') except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition.

Now, right off the bat, if there's a revelation of the son of perdition, there's got to be a revelation of the Son of man, and the fact of the matter is: the revelation of the Son of man has to come before the revelation of the son of perdition. It can't be otherwise, because one's a counterfeit. You cannot have it.

64. So, It tells you right there, there's going to be a revelation exactly of the character who's behind what. There'll be a revelation of the character behind the seed of righteousness; there'll be revelation behind the seed of discrepancy. Conformity, revelation; discrepancy, revelation. Who's behind it? You've got to have it because there's always twins.

Now, this is why I stuck with and try to get you to understand twins. You simply can't have the left hand without the right hand. God's not crippled. He wouldn't even allow a priesthood to have anything wrong, like a bit of your finger cut off, or you're born wrong; no way could you be in the priesthood. It has to be a perfect body, not one cell too many, not one cell too less, just one hundred percent. That's the way the Bride of Christ is. That's the way Christ is, absolutely perfect.

65. Now, It says here:

- (4) Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; ...(sits) as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. (Brother Branham said, *forgiving sins*.)
- (5) Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? (Now, he tells them. And this is all part of Matthew 24.)
- (6) ...now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

Now, It tells you right here, "Till he be revealed in his time." Now, there's a very special revelation there, and there's a very special revelation concerning the One, 'where is He'? He's up here in 2 Thessalonians, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven. There's a revelation coming of one, a revelation of the other. There's a people separated: one group over here, and one group over there. See, that's the picture I want you to understand.

66. Now, and note that even as God is glorified and admired in the Bride, you have this also as a forerunner and is going on at this very minute: it is established that always there are twins. And since this is so, we remember Lk 18:8 again, the Son of man; Matthew 12, the Son of man; Jn 17:12, the son of perdition. "One of you has Satan indwelling you. One of you is the devil." And Jesus mentioned him as the son of perdition, and Bro. Branham put the twins together: Son of man, son of perdition; Son of God, son of perdition. Always, always there are those twins in there.

67. So, you can see clearly in 2 Thessalonians 2, you have the Son of man, you have the son of perdition. And you have both of those positively manifesting in the spirit. You'll find both of those positively will come forth in flesh. And you will find the devil incarnate Judas; you will find that God will incarnate Jesus. And you will find that Jesus will come down incarnated by God and face the devil, who is incarnated in a pope, a leading figure of religion. And there'll be a confrontation. But before that can happen, it has to be the understanding that we have at this hour: the perfect truth as Paul had it. And the perfect truth as Paul had it, which we showed you here in 2 Thessalonians, is what Bro. Branham brought us. And he said, "*Always, they're twins: Son of man; son of perdition.*" See? Cain, Abel, right down the line. Okay.

68. Thus we see the son of perdition; so then, there must be the twin, which is the Son of man. Now then, that's "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever." Can't change. No way. People think it's otherwise. They think it merely, "Well, there's Mark 16; you've got a life to live; you've got gifts to have; you've got fruit to bear.

That's all true. I don't say one thing against it. But that is not Heb 13:8. Hebrews 13:8 is Genesis 18: God dealing with His people through a prophet. And we would not have known that except for a vindicated prophet. And remember; that man, like every other prophet, (And Paul is the great one in this: we look back to him.) he could not say anything...(Even Balaam knew that he couldn't say one thing...) except God let him say it.

69. Isaac found out when he blessed Jacob. You know, Jacob's mother, Rebekah, didn't have to have her son fool around. She just could have said, "Son, listen; you're the one that's going to get the blessing." But she really didn't know it. She thought that Esau was going to do it. So, she had him dress up, you know, with all these skins on, and he fooled the old man.

And the old man was flabbergasted. He said, "My God, what have I done?"

He knew what he did. God spoke through him, and he couldn't change if he tried. He said, "Then who did I bless? Who? What...?"

Hey, if you came here and there was a phony signed bill of agreement, you could take that guy in court and bust him. Do you think God wouldn't have busted Isaac for falsely prophesying? or the son? Sure, He would have busted him. It wouldn't have come to pass. But this man Isaac knew what he said would come to pass.

Now, why would it come to pass? Because God spoke through him! Then he said, "Oh, what can I do for my poor boy I love?" "Well," he said, "it won't be too hard, there's blessings I can give him, but they won't be worth a hoot in a basket. Well, son, (he said,) "I'll give you some nice dew in the morning, and grass for your camels and these good things, too." But the birthright was gone.

70. See, Isaac did not want to face up to truth, and God made him face up. And many times you and I don't want to face up, but God made us right there. Or why would I have said, "When was he ever wrong?" You've got to come to the time, there's no more feelings, there's no more anything of that nature.

All right, now where did these twins originate and come to fruition, as they do come to fruition, the Son of man in Matthew 12, and the son of perdition in 2 Thessalonians 13-14?

71. Now, remember; the son of perdition did miracles just like Jesus, like all the rest of them, a miracle ministry. It started right on the day of Pentecost through a prophecy, which Peter took from Joel, and referred to the last two days. And that's over here in... I'm not going to read the whole chapter: Joel 2:1-21; but It says here: [Acts 2:16]

- (16) This is that spoken by the prophet Joel; (When the Holy Ghost came down and spread Himself over the whole body,)
- (17) ...in the last days, I will pour out...my Spirit upon all flesh (the last two thousand years): and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, ...your young men shall see visions, ...your old men dream dreams:
- (18) And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: (Going on two thousand years. Now, watch where He ends up, at the Great Tribulation.)
- (19) And I will shew wonders in the heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; and blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:
- (20) The sun turned into darkness, ...the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:
- (21) It shall come to pass, *that* whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Now, he tells you right there, start right back there. "Your sons, my sons;" God's children, the other bunch. They'll all have an anointing. "Pour my Spirit upon all flesh." They'll prophesy. They'll do mighty works. It started way back there; it's been going on for two thousand years, and, of course, the harvest is always the great time, because that's when the seed comes to full maturity.

72. Okay. Then we saw Paul came vindicated, and we saw the false prophets and teachers rise up. So, watch; twins everywhere: light and dark, truth and error, life and death, good and evil, righteousness/wickedness, obedience/disobedience, blessing and cursing, right hand/left hand, conformity/discrepancy, child of God/child of Satan, Abel/Cain, Jacob/Esau, Isaac and Ishmael. There's Sarah and Hagar; there's the New Jerusalem of heaven, there's the one on earth, the earthly Jerusalem; there's grace and there's law; there's hot and there's cold; et cetera, et cetera. You can't get by.

73. So, let us look at twins again in 2 Th 2:7. It says:

(7) The mystery of iniquity doth already work...

Now, 'iniquity; is 'the violation or bending of the law or Word of God'. Now, just a minute. When you violate something, it means that you attack it and do something with it. When you bend it, it means you're doing it to an advantage to hurt somebody else. So therefore, iniquity in the Scripture, (And we'll check this out in a minute.) 'iniquity' is 'the violation or bending of the law or the Word of God'.

Now, the question is: Who is the twin? See? The twin of what? The mystery of iniquity. It is not righteousness per se, but the adhering to and unbending acceptance of the revealed Word: "Live, die, sink or swim," the superimposition of the vindicated Word upon all beliefs that we might have held or want to hold, obliterating it, so it now has no use, and we leave it entirely as dung, because that doesn't have any use to the human being. It might be good for a few plants, but it certainly is no good for the human being.

So, the twin of the mystery of iniquity is not righteousness. No way. It's to believe the unbending Word and be a witness to It. Now, these two spirits were back in the Garden of Eden and reappeared at Pentecost, and now are here today awaiting to be incarnated.

74. This thought on the twins resolves my often asked question, "Is the mystery of iniquity the major doctrine that includes serpent seed, or is serpent seed the doctrine that includes the mystery of iniquity?" Well, we're going to find out right now from the Bible. See, if you ask you a question, Bro. Branham said it's all in the Bible.

So, let's go to Ezek 28:15.

(15) Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

Now, what does the word 'iniquity' mean in the Hebrew? It means 'to distort'. So, "You were perfect until you fooled with my Word and distorted It."

So, that should open up the whole picture of what Bro. Branham's been teaching and I've been teaching the last thirty years since he's gone. This puts it in a perfect, scriptural light that we didn't have until this moment—or at least I didn't have, and perhaps you didn't either.

75. Here is why Bro. Branham used continuously—continually, rather, and continuously, after he preached his message, Rev 22:18-19:

- (18) For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of (the) book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:
- (19) And if any man shall take away...the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, ...out of the holy city, and the things which are written in this book.

You cannot even add one word. As Bro. Branham said, "*I must be careful with my illustrations, lest I change a meaning.*"

So therefore, the adding or taking of the Word merely lets you know one word can absolutely change or distort the Word of God, and if you are a distorter, you are serpent seed. The serpent came and distorted the Word of God. He was an animal, so close to human being, he could reason, and he did—and he could speak. And Satan used him because Satan must have children the way God has children. God does not come down and make a woman and impregnate her. He has the male and a female, and they are male and female for one thing, as Bro. Branham said, "*Sex was there for one thing only, for procreation*." We'll talk about that sometime when I talk on 'stewardship'. Till then, that's on the rear burner.

76. In the meantime people are all messed up in their thinking. But we are not here in this place messed up in our thinking. We may not do right; we may be very mischievous many things we do, but I can tell you one thing: we have this Word of God down pat the same as David did, who knew he shouldn't commit adultery, who knew he shouldn't lust for a neighbor's wife, who knew he shouldn't kill. Yes, we sin a thousand times a day, and backslide a thousand times a day. And evil with us, many times we're just too happy for it.

But we know! And we can recognize God and know His Word, and we don't bend It. We may bend ourselves. There's not one of you ever committed adultery, but you know you committed adultery! And some of you had to tell your wives, and it sure was embarrassing, but it served you right. How about men who got to confess to their wives; oh, they want a beautiful little girl that's a virgin. Well, a lot of you

men better be virgins. What do you think you are? Works both ways. Adam was a virgin the same time Eve was a virgin.

You say, "Well, Bro. Vayle."

Don't 'Bro. Vayle me'. The world's going to stand before God for the very things I teach, getting from a prophet. That's not the unforgivable sin. I'm not a fool that I don't know that.

77. Now, watch. Verse 20 follows 18 and 19. [Revelation 22]

- (20) He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
- (21) The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you all.

That follows the Scripture that says don't you dare take a word or don't you dare add a word, because it's that time Christ Himself comes physically. If He hadn't come, the Holy Spirit had not come to a prophet, we would add any word and take any word, and we would not be the ones to get out of here, because we're coming to a perfection.

78. Now, this distortion all started in the Garden of Eden. In Ezek 28:11:

- (11) Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- (12) Son of man, (That's prophet.) take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.
- (13) Thou hast been in Eden (Come on, that guy wasn't in Eden; that was the devil in Eden.)

Now, look at this fellow here. Come on I want you to get a beautiful picture here.

(13) Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; (and at that time,) every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, (the) topaz, ...the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, ...the jaspire, the sapphire, the emerald, ...the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in that day that thou wast created.

Why, he's in the high priest robes! Except they don't match up. I checked this out. Read it for yourself. Look at the jewels in New Jerusalem. They don't check with this. There's a discrepancy.

79. Now, watch. Watch carefully. This is a high priest that was in the Garden of Eden! Huh? Yep, a high priest in the Garden of Eden. He got to lead in the worship of God. He's going to teach the bride. And he does. He doesn't teach the groom. He just falls into sin like David. David knew he shouldn't lust, shouldn't commit adultery, shouldn't kill. He did it. Adam knew. He played Jesus. He took her to himself so that she wouldn't die. Of course, God knew all about that, but it's okay by me. But listen; let's keep reading now.

(13) ...the workmanship of thy tabrets and...thy pipes (were) prepared in thee in that day that thou wast created.

To do what? To do this very thing here that he did. "You stood there with Michael who was Jesus"—Jesus impersonated in Michael. "You stood there and led in the worship, and you knew all about me. You know all the Word, and you bent It. And you were made a priest and a worshipper to bend It." 80. Now, come on now, let's go a little further. Eve was taken from Adam, and she was a by-product, because "*It was not complementary to God that a son of God, straight from God, like Adam, would fall.*" Right? Quoting the prophet. So, here he is all laid out. And Satan is all laid out as a roaring lion to fool people; he's all made out as a wonderful worshipper; he's all made out to lead in every church service while they pray in Father, Son and Holy Ghost, and sing all about the holy Trinity, lay hands on the sick and the cripples walk, the demented walk out whole, blind see, deaf hear, Benny Hinn blows on them. He doesn't even blow, and they fall over. And that's the devil, and they get up healed. Come on! Lorne Fox started it! I've got the history. Yeah. The devil.

Oh, he'll sing, "Oh, how I love Jesus."

What Jesus are you singing about?

"Why, of course, the second person of the Trinity."

Never heard of him; never heard of him. That's right. I don't... Why, you talk about... I don't know anything about a second person. Why should I? The Word of the prophet of God, vindicated, has superimposed upon itself upon my thinking of this person and that person and that person; 'ain't no thing as one, two, three. It's one, the Father; two, Jesus; and the Holy Spirit is the life of Almighty God, the same life that's in him'. And we're all a part of it, part of a seed of God. See?

81. So, we could go on, but it's always twins. Just remember; Mt 13:30 said: "I'm going to let them grow together until the time of the harvest, and I'll destroy the one, but not the other."

As It says over here also in Revelation 13, they're going to, everybody, worship the beast and worship in the beast system, which is the twisted word.

82. And don't think for one minute that this Message is not being twisted right today. If I were so naïve as to try to tell you, like one guy wrote a letter, a preacher, and he said, "I don't understand why all this talk," he said, "is fighting about the thunders and the Presence and the two gods or three gods and this and that." Why he said, "I just look at this wonderful tremendous Message that Bro. Branham brought, and each one of us has our own little, lovely interpretation and revelation. We should get together; it's so marvelous."

83. They tell me had a big conference out there west somewhere. I think it was perhaps up in Canada. And the preachers could preach, maybe thirty-seven preachers were preaching, and they'd give them fifteen minute breaks for recess, maybe have an apple or go the restroom or something, and a fellow said, "You should have heard the confusion, about thirty-seven preachers preaching thirty-seven different things."

Why did Paul say, then, "all say the same thing?" You tell me. Why'd he bother?

"Paul you're an idiot. You know we're not going to say the same thing. Why'd you tell us?"

Because he said, "You can."

And Bro. Branham said, "*Let ten think the same thoughts, say the same thing in one room, there'll be a rapture.*" Ten is all it takes—ten. See?

84. Don't bend the Word, brother/sister. Don't fool with It, because they're all going to go and worship the beast. And remember; those who worship the beast, let's find out what happens to them while the saints are gathered in glory and they're going to be taken away to the New Jerusalem and all the wonderful things of Almighty God. It says in Rev 20:11:

(11) And I saw a great white throne, and (so on)...

- (12) And I saw the dead, great and small, stand before God; and the books were opened... the dead were judged (Notice; judged, judged, judged.) out of those things...written in the books, according to their works. ("I never knew you," see?)
- (13) ... the sea gave up the dead...
- (14) And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- (15) And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

What's the second death? The first death are dead in their trespasses in sins in a human body that dies. Then they're brought back to life in a body commensurate, either like the Bride body of Christ, or another body, and they're thrown into the Lake of Fire, and they're destroyed.

85 So, there's your seeds, my brother/sister. There's the understanding of twins. And I believe tonight now, we can almost, not really forget about twins, but I think with all my heart you have an understanding, and I have an understanding now we didn't have before, and it nails it all down right from the throne of God, where the literal worship took place, and there stood Satan, and he began to bend the Word. He began to bend the Word and bend the Word.

86. Listen, don't bend this Word. Look at It; take It. You're never going to live It. I can tell you right now. You're not going to live It, not unless the Holy Spirit gets a hold of your mind and my mind in such a way It just puts it in a vice. We'll have problems the day we live; every day we live we're going to have problems. I concur with Bro. Branham and the apostle Paul: the good we do, we just fall by the wayside, and we do something else instead. I'm not telling you now to live immoral lives or be loose. I'm just saying, look; you have got to come to this place and understand this: you were perfect until you bent the Word. Now then, if we no longer bend the Word, where are we? Perfect. That's what you're looking at. Well, if you're satisfied, I'm satisfied.

Let's bow our heads and pray.

Heavenly Father, we thank You again for the time we've had together, a little fellowship around the Word, and, Lord, we're glad that we've conformed to the image of Christ Who conformed to You, because He was that image, and we have it by grace, we have it by birth; we have it by impartation; we have a part representation because we were there. And we don't understand that, a little mystery there, but we don't need to understand it, because we were in Him and now coming down here by natural means that You ordained, Lord, coming back now by supernatural means that You ordained, not bending the Word.

God help us from this minute on, never, never, never line up with Satan, never line up with anybody who bends the Word and says, "Let's look at it this way; let's look at it that way." Father God, help us. We've got an eye single to Your glory, and Your glory is now You are being glorified in Your Church and we can see You're being glorified correctly and properly and worshipped because nobody wants to bend this Word.

Now, help us, Lord, in our carefulness that we don't get overwrought; we don't get too suspicious, or carried away, but we just stand with the truth, and where we don't understand some things, to stand steady, Lord, until we get the truth, and above all, Lord, to be in obedience to It in whatever way we can possibly do it. And we know we can, Lord.

So, help us in every way, shape, and form, what we've heard tonight to conform, Lord, right to You and to Your Son, forming a perfect triumphant of the Father and the Only-begotten Son, and all those sons forming a Bride around him. And those others, Lord, they've got a part in there I don't understand, but we can leave that knowing that we've been spoken to as the very elect, and believe we are a part of that election, by the grace of Almighty God, just going onwards, onward, onward, helped by the Holy Spirit indwelling us.

So now, Lord, as we go to the Communion service, we pray that You'll bless us together. May Your Name be glorified. In Jesus' Name, we pray. Amen.
